Holistic Community Education

OPRFHS will collaborate with all educational institutions within both villages to create seamless transitions allowing each student to be well known and supported by adults as we build an engaged, socially responsible, and responsive citizenry.

Equity

The adults and students at OPRFHS will create an environment where the academic achievement and social and emotional development of students will no longer be predictable by race.

Supportive Learning Environment

OPRFHS will foster a learning environment that supports and affirms the complexity of individual identities; values trust, risk-taking, reflection and self-advocacy; and creates and nurtures a system of supports to meet the evolving needs of all students.

Transformational Teaching, Learning and Leadership

OPRFHS will provide rich, engaging learning opportunities that set high expectations for all students and foster collaboration, problem solving, reflection, critical thinking and independent learning.

OPRFHS will monitor student progress, using this information to revise and improve instruction and learning. Student progress is quantifiable and documents the transformation of student learning and achievement through specific teaching practices.

OPRFHS will support all educators with professional growth and collaboration opportunities so they can provide active, powerful, and effective leadership, teaching, and learning for our students. OPRFHS is a safe place for adult growth, and all policies and practices support the teaching and learning environment.
