Working Draft of Value Statement Categories

Holistic Community Education – An education deeply rooted in and supported by an engaged community that includes a highly articulated, seamless education from cradle through college and prepares students for engaged citizenship and lifelong learning.

Equity – Education that provides all that is needed for each student to achieve success and that celebrates diversity while ensuring that race, income, gender and special education status are not predictors of achievement.

Supportive Learning Environment – An environment that provides a safe and respectful place of learning that encourages engagement in the school community, and addresses the individual and collective needs of the entire school community with particular emphasis on student social emotional needs and learning.

Transformational Teaching and Learning – Education that provides a broad repertoire of instructional strategies such as critical thinking, problem solving and collaborative learning differentiated to engage successful teaching and learning by all students.

Facilities and Finance – A physical environment and adequate resources that fully support the individual and collective needs of the entire school community, provide state-of-the art technology and support adult capacity and talent to maximize learning opportunities for all students.
