**The Back-to-School Packet is online only.** We do not send the documents via regular mail. On the back of this letter is a list of packet documents found by going to [oprfs.org](http://oprfs.org). Look for the Quick Link on the bottom right of the homepage called *Back-to-School Packet*.

**Skyward/Family Access is our student information portal.** You can download the Skyward mobile app from your app store, or go to our homepage ([oprfs.org](http://oprfs.org)) and look for the Quick Link called Family Access. Don't know your password? Go to our Family Access login page and click "Forgot your Login/Password?". Please note that student schedules will not be available for viewing until Schedule Pick Up Week in August.

**All 2019-2020 fees are payable now and are due by July 25:** This includes the Instructional Materials Fee (\$268), the Technology Fee (\$50), and the District Fee (varies by grade). You can pay your fees online through your Family Access account or in person at the Bookstore. To set up a payment plan, visit the Bookstore (summer hours: 7:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.). Please note: We do not release a student's schedule during Schedule Pickup Week (see enclosed schedule) unless all fees are paid, including any outstanding fees from last year.

**Required summer reading and math packets:** All students, including incoming freshmen, need to complete summer reading and a math packet before the first day of school. For more information, go to [oprfs.org](http://oprfs.org) and look in the lower right corner for the Quick Links called *Summer Reading* and *Summer Math Packets*.
