Board approves hybrid learning plan

At a special meeting this past Thursday, Dec. 3, the Board of Education approved our hybrid learning plan for second semester. To see the plan, please [click here](#).

Deadline to opt into/out of on-site classes extended to Dec. 14

- **If you do not make your selection by this date, your child automatically be placed in remote-only classes for the full second semester; they will *not* be able to switch to on-site classes later.**

- We anticipate sending students their cohort assignments by the time second semester classes begin on Monday, Jan. 11.
- **NOTE:** We will not implement hybrid learning until it is safe to do so. The soonest hybrid learning might begin would be January 19. This date, however, depends on local and county COVID-19 metrics
