

OPRF Homecoming Dance 2022

"OPRF MET GALA"

Advanced Tickets:

- OPRF Students- \$22 through ticketleap 9/14-9/28, 8:00am-Midnight
- OPRF Student - CASH ONLY days in bookstore: Wednesday 9/21 and Wednesday 9/28
- Non-OPRF Student Guests- \$30 in the Bookstore (WITH completed guest form) from 9/14-9/28, 7:30am-3:30pm
- OPRF Students- \$30 at the door the day of the dance (no guests will be allowed to buy tickets at door)

Non-OPRF Student Guests:

- OPRF students can attend the dance with 1 Non-OPRF student guest, if desired.
- Non-OPRF Student Guest Tickets require a completed permission form and copy of their State ID or Current Student ID to be purchased.
- Non-OPRF Student Guest Tickets must be purchased 9/14-9/28 in the Bookstore, 7:30am- 3:30pm, and are \$30.
- OPRF Students must enter the dance WITH their Non-OPRF Student Guest through the Welcome Center (Door4). Non-OPRF Students will not be allowed entry without their OPRF Student with them.

Details:

- Students must serve all disciplinary obligations, including detentions, by 9/28 to be admitted into the dance. Students will not be allowed entry nor will they get a refund if they have not met their obligations.
- Doors open at 7pm and close promptly at 7:45pm. **NO entry after 7:45pm, no refunds** for late arrivals
- Allow enough time to park and walk to the door, no student will be admitted after 7:45pm
- Students with advanced tickets, enter through Driver's Ed Doors (Door 3).
- OPRF Students with NON-OPRF Guests and students purchasing tickets at the door, enter through the Welcome Center (Door 4)
- Students must have their current Student ID with them in order to enter the dance.

Attire:

- The Homecoming Dance is a Semi-formal event and casual clothing should not be worn.
- **All Clothing must be appropriate under the guidelines of the School Dress Code.** No Costumes may be worn.
- **Students dressed inappropriately may be rejected admission and no refund will be issued.**

Behavior Expectations:

- Appropriate Dancing is expected. Inappropriate dancing will result in a time out, ejection from the dance, and/or parent notification.
- Students and Non-OPRF Student Guests are expected to obey the Code of Conduct at all School-Sponsored activities on and off campus.
 - If a student is suspected of being under the influence, a parent will be called. If a parent is unreachable, the student may be turned over to the local police.
 - The School's drug and alcohol policy will be enforced (see student handbook).
