Talavara CDD Landscape Report 11/10/25

Good afternoon, Members of the Board, Sean and Miss Evelyn-

My apologies, but I will not be able to attend the Board meeting this month. I had a death in the family which has me leaving town on 11/11/25 and then upon returning, will be leaving again on 11/17/25.

There has been no major issues to report for the month and I should be present for the December meeting.

Maintenance: Things are growing sloooowly now! Pond mowing will be reduced to every other week in most areas to alleviate potential erosion issues, especially when the dry season starts. This will also allow some natural seed pod growth to strengthen/thicken the grass. Conservation cut backs will begin in a sequenced pattern throughout the winter season. High focal areas will be addressed on a regular basis to keep conservation areas cut back for a neat appearance. Outlying areas will be addressed after initial cutback on an as need basis.

<u>Irrigation</u>: A few minor breaks have been reported and repaired. We were notified by Miss Evelyn that the irrigation system was still running through its last zones on 11/8/25 (Saturday) while vendors needed to set up for an event. We shut the system down and have arranged with Miss Evelyn to reach out to us any time there is an event occurring during the mid-late morning and we will postpone the irrigation ahead of time so there is no issue.

Fertilization: Fertilization treatment for this month will be turf fertilizer with micro nutrients.

<u>Flowers:</u> Proposal presented for the installation of poinsettias as we did last year. The installation would happen the week after Thanksgiving.

<u>Landscape</u>: No major issues reported on the foundation landscape and nothing noted during walk/drive through.

A proposal for the second installation of mulch is attached for review and approval. In the RFP it reflects a full install installation in April of 400 yards, and a 300 yard "recover" for October... but in my opinion, based on the new installs and current mulch condition, I feel that this can be reduced to 200 yards without any impact noticed. This would reduce the propose by \$5,500.00. If this is the direction the Board wishes to proceed- please hand-write the new amount on proposal and forward as I will not be back in town until after the week of 11/22.

Pond FPC7- Still have not been able to connect with Jason on this. Will try again upon return.





Coastal had picked up our recycling last week, Tues. Oct. 28, 2025 and fully emptied it since it was 3/4's full. However, again this week yesterday our can was only a fifth full and they didn't fully empty our recycling can again. Seems to be selective emptying. What It is, the sanitation recycling person is just to lazy to lift up the recycling can and empty it in full. as he is supposed to do. Instead, he sticks his arm in and grabs a hand full of what he can, then leaves the rest behind and moves on.

Please see pictures below from yesterday, Tuesday Nov. 4, 2025 where the first picture shows that Coastal opened the lid to our recycling can. The second picture shows what was left in our pail after the person stuck their arm in our pail and pulled out a hand full of recycling and then left all the rest in the pail then moved on. All items are fully approved for recycling. No glass. No Styrofoam. No number 6 plastic.

I had contacted Coastal and spoke with a lady named Eileen and she had said that the actions of their employee was unacceptable. However, this doesn't seem to go anywhere as to have corrected actions taken. They aren't doing their jobs that they are contracted and compensated to do, which we all here are paying for. What is the purpose of recycling when they don't fully do what they are supposed to do and getting paid to do?. I was told by them that the manager James would contact me or stop by to talk with us and pick up the remaining recycling. We didn't here anything back and nobody came to pick up the remaining recycling that was left in our recycling can.

In speaking with many neighbors in this community, during our conversations we have learned that this is happening to many of them as well, as to the point that they don't recycle anymore. Very poor! Bad for the environment and wildlife.


It just might be time to start looking for another Waste & Recycling company who will do their job properly for what they are being contracted and compensated to do.



Compliance Audit Overview

The Community Website Compliance Audit (CWCA) consists of a thorough assessment of Florida Community Development District (CDD) websites to assure that specified district information is available and fully accessible. Florida Statute Chapter 189.069 states that effective October, 2015, every CDD in the state is required to maintain a fully compliant website for reporting certain information and documents for public access.

The CWCA is a reporting system comprised of quarterly audits and an annual summary audit to meet full disclosure as required by Florida law. These audits are designed to assure that CDDs satisfy all compliance requirements stipulated in Chapter 189.069.

Compliance Criteria

The CWCA focuses on the two primary areas – website accessibility as defined by U.S. federal laws, and the 16-point criteria enumerated in <u>Florida Statute Chapter</u> 189.069.



ADA Website Accessibility

Several federal statutes (American Disabilities Act, Sec. 504 and 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973) require public institutions to ensure they are not discriminating against individuals on the basis of a person's disability. Community websites are required to conform to web content accessibility guidelines – WCAG 2.1, which is the international standard established to keep websites barrier-free and the recognized standard for ADA-compliance.



Florida Statute Compliance

Pursuant to F.S. <u>189.069</u>, every CDD is required to maintain a dedicated website to serve as an official reporting mechanism covering, at minimum, 16 criteria. The information required to report and have fully accessible spans: establishment charter or ordinance, fiscal year audit, budget, meeting agendas and minutes and more. For a complete list of statute requirements, see page 3.

Audit Process

The Community Website Compliance Audit covers all CDD web pages and linked PDFs.* Following the <u>WCAG 2.1</u> levels A, AA, and AAA for web content accessibility, a comprehensive scan encompassing 312 tests is conducted for every page. In addition, a human inspection is conducted to assure factors such as navigation and color contrasts meet web accessibility standards. See page 4 for complete accessibility grading criteria.

In addition to full ADA-compliance, the audit includes a 16-point checklist directly corresponding with the criteria set forth in Florida Statute Chapter 189.069. See page 5 for the complete compliance criteria checklist.

* NOTE: Because many CDD websites have links to PDFs that contain information required by law (meeting agendas, minutes, budgets, miscellaneous and ad hoc documents, etc.), audits include an examination of all associated PDFs. PDF remediation and ongoing auditing is critical to maintaining compliance.

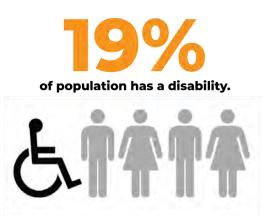

Accessibility overview

Everyone deserves equal access.

With nearly 1-in-5 Americans having some sort of disability – visual, hearing, motor, cognitive – there are literally millions of reasons why websites should be fully accessible and compliant with all state and federal laws. Web accessibility not only keeps board members on the right side of the law, but enables the entire community to access all your web content. The very principles that drive accessible website design are also good for those without disabilities.



Sight, hearing, physical, cognitive.

The legal and right thing to do

Several federal statutes (American Disabilities Act, Sec. 504 and 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973) require public institutions to ensure they are not discriminating against individuals on the basis of a person's disability. Community websites are required to conform to web content accessibility guidelines, WCAG 2.1, the international standard established to keep websites barrier-free. Plain and simple, any content on your website must be accessible to everyone.



ADA Compliance Categories

Most of the problems that occur on a website fall in one or several of the following categories.



Contrast and colors

Some people have vision disabilities that hinder picking up contrasts, and some are color blind, so there needs to be a distinguishable contrast between text and background colors. This goes for buttons, links, text on images – everything. Consideration to contrast and color choice is also important for extreme lighting conditions.

Using semantics to format your HTML pages

When web page codes are clearly described in easy-to-understand terms, it enables broader sharing across all browsers and apps. This 'friendlier' language not only helps all the users, but developers who are striving to make content more universal on more devices.



Text alternatives for non-text content

Written replacements for images, audio and video should provide all the same descriptors that the non-text content conveys. Besides helping with searching, clear, concise word choice can make vivid non-text content for the disabled.

Ability to navigate with the keyboard

Not everyone can use a mouse. Blind people with many with motor disabilities have to use a keyboard to make their way around a website. Users need to be able to interact fully with your website by navigating using the tab, arrows and return keys only. A "skip navigation" option is also required. Consider using WAI-ARIA for improved accessibility, and properly highlight the links as you use the tab key to make sections.

Easy to navigate and find information

Finding relevant content via search and easy navigation is a universal need. Alt text, heading structure, page titles, descriptive link text (no 'click here' please) are just some ways to help everyone find what they're searching for. You must also provide multiple ways to navigate such as a search and a site map.

Properly formatting tables

Tables are hard for screen readers to decipher. Users need to be able to navigate through a table one cell at a time. In addition to the table itself needing a caption, row and column headers need to be labeled and data correctly associated with the right header.

Alternate versions

Attempts to be fully accessible sometimes fall short, and in those cases, alternate versions of key pages must be created. That is, it is sometimes not feasible (legally, technically) to modify some content. These are the 'exceptions', but still must be accommodated.



Feedback for users

To be fully interactive, your site needs to be able to provide an easy way for users to submit feedback on any website issues. Clarity is key for both any confirmation or error feedback that occurs while engaging the page.



Other related requirements

No flashing

Blinking and flashing are not only bothersome, but can be disorienting and even dangerous for many users. Seizures can even be triggered by flashing, so avoid using any flashing or flickering content.

Timers

Timed connections can create difficulties for the disabled. They may not even know a timer is in effect, it may create stress. In some cases (e.g., purchasing items), a timer is required, but for most school content, avoid using them.

Fly-out menus

Menus that fly out or down when an item is clicked are helpful to dig deeper into the site's content, but they need to be available via keyboard navigation, and not immediately snap back when those using a mouse move from the clickable area.

No pop-ups

Pop-up windows present a range of obstacles for many disabled users, so it's best to avoid using them altogether. If you must, be sure to alert the user that a pop-up is about to be launched.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TALAVERA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT IMPLEMENTING SECTION 190.006(3), FLORIDA STATUTES, AND REQUESTING THAT THE PASCO COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS BEGIN CONDUCTING THE DISTRICT'S GENERAL ELECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATION; SETTING FORTH THE TERMS OF OFFICE; AUTHORIZING NOTICE OF THE QUALIFYING PERIOD; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Talavera Community Development District ("**District**") is a local unit of special-purpose government created and existing pursuant to Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*, being situated entirely within Pasco County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the District ("Board") seeks to implement Section 190.006(3), *Florida Statutes*, and to instruct the Pasco County Supervisor of Elections ("Supervisor") to conduct the District's elections by the qualified electors of the District at the general election ("General Election").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TALAVERA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT:

1. GENERAL ELECTION SEATS.

Seat 4, currently held by Pamela Plehal Length of term: Four years Seat 5, currently held by Richard Henderson Length of term: Four years

are scheduled for the General Election beginning in November 2026. The District Manager is hereby authorized to notify the Supervisor of Elections as to what seats are subject to General Election for the current election year, and for each subsequent election year.

- 2. **QUALIFICATION PROCESS.** For each General Election, all candidates shall qualify for individual seats in accordance with Section 99.061, *Florida Statutes*, and must also be a qualified elector of the District. A qualified elector is any person at least 18 years of age who is a citizen of the United States, a legal resident of the State of Florida and of the District, and who is registered to vote with the Pasco County Supervisor of Elections. Campaigns shall be conducted in accordance with Chapter 106, *Florida Statutes*.
- 3. **COMPENSATION.** Members of the Board receive \$200 per meeting for their attendance and no Board member shall receive more than \$4,800 per year.
- 4. **TERM OF OFFICE.** The term of office for the individuals to be elected to the Board in the General Election is four years. The newly elected Board members shall assume office on the second Tuesday following the election.

- 5. **REQUEST TO SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS.** The District hereby requests the Supervisor to conduct the District's General Election in November 2026, and for each subsequent General Election unless otherwise directed by the District's Manager. The District understands that it will be responsible to pay for its proportionate share of the General Election cost and agrees to pay same within a reasonable time after receipt of an invoice from the Supervisor.
- 6. **PUBLICATION.** The District Manager is directed to publish a notice of the qualifying period for each General Election, in a form substantially similar to **Exhibit A** attached hereto at least two weeks prior to the start of the qualifying period.
- 7. **SEVERABILITY.** The invalidity or unenforceability of any one or more provisions of this Resolution shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining portions of this Resolution, or any part thereof.
 - 8. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage.
