Summary, Hidden Creek Blvd

General Updates, Recent & Upcoming Maintenance Events.

- ➤ Overall, the property requires extensive weeding and plant bed detailing. The current condition is unacceptable and must be addressed promptly to meet maintenance standards.
- Please continue edging the beds to maintain defined boundaries before they become overgrown.

The following are action items for Juniper Landscaping to complete. Please refer to the item # in your response listing action already taken or anticipated time of completion. Red text indicates deficient from previous report. Bold Red text indicates deficient for more than a month. Green text indicates a proposal has been requested. Blue indicates irrigation. Orange text represents Staff and bold, black, underlined represents questions or information for the BOS.

 Juniper - begin scheduling dates for trimming all designated palm trees and removing spent fruits and flowers prior to further development. (Pic 1)



- In the front beds along Hidden Creek and Eiland Blvd, the bed lines are becoming lost in the turf, and several areas have washed out pine bark mulch. The crew should bring a couple of bags of mulch to fill in the bare spot and restore the bed appearance. (Pic 2>)
- The median beds along Hidden Creek require detailing, as encroaching turf is obscuring the bed edges. The crew should restore clean, defined bed lines and ensure the plantings are clearly separated from the turf. (Pic 3>)
- 4. Same area as above, please have the crews thin out and clean up the lilies.

5. In the median beds, a young crape myrtle tree is currently leaning. It appears suitable for strapping and adjustment to an upright position. Juniper should evaluate the tree and determine the appropriate corrective action.

6. If not already completed, the crew should trim the firebush along the curbs on both sides of the median on Hidden Creek to maintain proper clearance and appearance. (Pic 6)



7. Leaf spots have been observed on the Golden Mound shrubs in the median beds along Hidden Creek, particularly in areas where the plants are thinning. Please dispatch an AG team to assess and diagnose the cause. (Pic 7a, 7b>)



- 8. Tall weedy growth along the preserve line, particularly adjacent to Hidden Creek, is beginning to encroach onto the common areas. The crew should cut back and remove these plants from the turf side to maintain clear and tidy areas. (Pic 8>)
- A thinning area has been observed in the Star Jasmine shrub. The detail team....

.... should prune out all dead material and remove clippings from the tops of the shrubs to support healthy development (Pic 9)



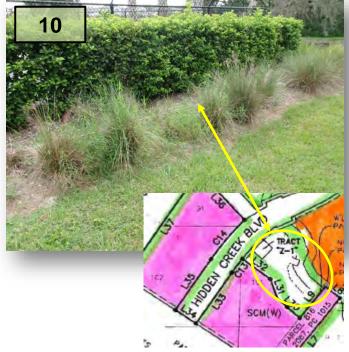

10. The area around the Pump Station on Hidden Creek requires immediate detailing. This was noted in last month's report and has not yet been addressed. Please ensure this area is properly tended during the next detailing event. (Pic 10)



11. Have the crew bring a cutting tool to remove approx. 6-inches of the Virginia Creeper vine, taking care not to cut from the tree trunks to avoid bark damage. The base of the vine should be removed and treated with herbicide to eliminate the roots on all vines along particularly south of the Pump Station on Hidden Creek. (Pic 11)



12. The recently trimmed area in the large field is appreciated; however, could the crew bring in soil to fill the exposed hole and top it with pine straw to maintain a clean and finished appearance. (Pic 12)



- 13. During all mowing events, the crew should focus on lifting and removing Spanish moss from the trees, up to the requested 10 feet in green spaces, in accordance with contract specifications.
- 14. The Bald Cypress tree along the pond west of Hidden Creek is showing signs of decline, including suckering growth, browning leaves, and increased lichen throughout the canopy, indicating stress. This tree will continue to be monitored, but based on current conditions, it is expected to further decline in the near future. (Pic 14)

15. A few items to note: the crew continues to blow turf debris into the beds, which can contribute to the spread of disease. In addition, this bed still requires detailing, and the Fakahatchee grasses need to be trimmed and properly evaluated for issues. (Pic 15a, 15b, 15c>)





- 16. This tree remains in poor condition despite being noted in last month's report and a proposal made for removal and replacement. Immediate action is required to correct the issue: repair the support boards and re-strap the tree, as the current straps are digging into the trunk and causing further damage. Unless there is a proposal for removal. (Pic 16>)
- 17. The crew continues to mow in the direction of the tree rings, causing turf clippings to....



....accumulate in the mulch. This creates potential for disease and mold if the clippings become wet. The crew should adjust the mowing pattern or, at least blow out the tree rings to keep them free of debris. (Pic 17)







Daisy Meadow Loop, Castle Ridge Rd, Eiland Blvd

18. Behind the mail kiosk on Daisy Meadow, the mulch has washed out and the Fakahatchee grasses are in poor condition and require detailing. The detail team need to address this area; trim the grasses and bring in mulch to fill the bare spots for a clean, finished appearance. (Pic 18a, 18b, 18c>)





- 19. This is a pokeweed, in the mail kiosk area. While it is harmless to animals, it is poisonous if ingested by humans. As this location is used as a bus pick-up spot, there is concern that a child could ingest the berries once they develop. The plant should be removed immediately. (Pic 19>)
- 20. Along Eiland Blvd, between Castle Ridge and Hidden Creek, there are several issues to address, beginning with a dead palm tree that shows no signs of recovery. This palm....



....should be removed. And the fakahatchee grasses below are starting to brown. Please someone to diagnose, as this typically is the case of spider mites. (Pic 20)







21. Along Eiland Blvd, several Fakahatchee grasses are declining and require attention. The crew should cut back and remove dead material from the beds and verify that the irrigation system along Eiland is functioning properly. (Pic 21a, 21b, 21c)







22. A Sabal palm has died and should be diagnosed to confirm the cause of decline. Evaluation should determine whether the issue was due to disease, pest activity, or environmental stress, and ensure preventative measures are taken to protect the remaining Sabal palms. (Pic 22)



23. The pond west of Hidden Creek has three planting beds due north that require immediate attention. Torpedo grass is spreading throughout the Fakahatchee grasses, grass clippings are scattered within the mulch, and one of the beds contains a severely declining cypress tree and another bed has a declining oak. The crew should treat the weeds, detail all three beds, and provide a diagnosis for the declining cypress. (Pic 23a, 23b>, 23c>, 23d>)





24. The planting beds along Eiland require detailing and a thorough cleaning. The Fakahatchee grasses are browning and overrun with an abundance of weeds. The crew should treat and detail these beds to the expected standard, restoring them to a clean and well-maintained appearance. (Pic 24)



25. The mowing crew should stop blowing grass clippings onto electrical boxes. The mowing pattern should be adjusted to prevent this issue as well, and maintain a clean, safe appearance around the boxes. (Pic 25)



26. As noted in last month's report, the Fakahatchee grass on Eiland is being overtaken by torpedo grass. This issue must be addressed during the next detail visit. (Pic 26>)



27. As noted in last month's report, this tree requires maintenance. The dead material should be cut out, and any branches in need of limbing should be properly pruned. (Pic 27)



- 28. As noted in last month's report, this blueberry tree requires maintenance. Prune the necessary branches and shape the tree to maintain proper form and health. (Pic 28>)
- 29. Along Eiland, a section of the planting beds contains a large patch of various weedy plant materials. The crew should treat the weeds, remove all dead plant material, and continue detailing the remaining beds to maintain a clean and tidy appearance. (Pic 29a>, 29b>)
- 30. Throughout these beds, continue treating the weeds, as several areas remain in need of attention.



31. Reminder: Line-trim around all electrical and irrigation boxes during every mowing event to ensure clear and easy access for maintenance technicians.









32. The pond furthest west on the property has six planting beds, ALL of which are overrun with weeds, contain browning Fakahatchee grasses, stressed bottlebrush trees, and lack mulch. Immediate attention is required to detail these beds, as they are currently not being maintained to standard. (Pic 32a, 32b, 32c>, 32d>, 32e>)















North of Eiland Blvd

33. North of Eiland and west of the pond, two trees under 4" in diameter are showing signs of decline. The first tree has declined beyond recovery and should be removed during the next visit. The second tree is struggling but may recover; ongoing monitoring is required. An AG technician should be sent to diagnose the sycamore tree. (Pic 33a, 33b)





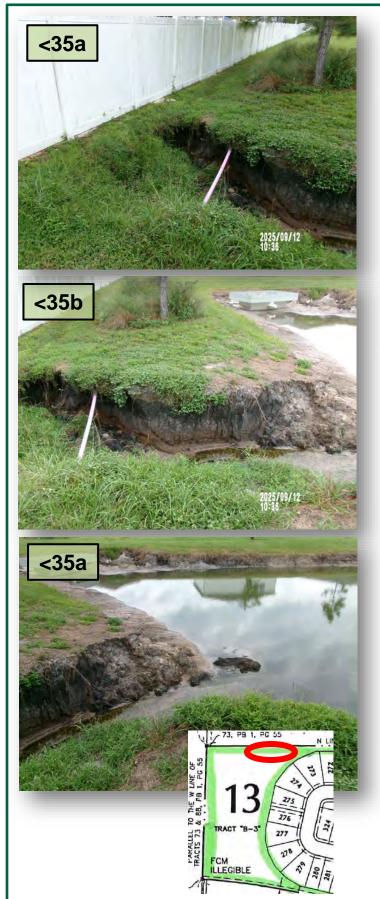
34. At the same pond as noted previously, three additional planting beds are not being maintained and lack defined bed edges. The crew should detail these beds by removing weeds, edging the beds, cleaning up the muhly grasses, and bringing mulch to fill any bare spots. (Pic 34a>, 34b>, 34c>)

35. Significant erosion is occurring along the back fence of the pond (see map for reference). An engineer should be dispatched to the site to evaluate the cause and assess the extent of the damage. (Pic 35a>, 35b>, 35c>)





North of Eiland Blvd, Castle Ridge Way



36. Along Castle Ridge planting bed located on the east side, one Loropetalum has already died. Please replace the plant during the next visit. (Pic 36)



37. The corner of Daisy Meadow and Castle Ridge, appears to have dead clippings from the jasmine and white paint on top of the shrub. Please have the crew visit, remove the debris, and evaluate the condition of the shrub. Additionally, please add mulch to the bare areas on this corner. (Pic 37)



38. Finally, the turf along the ROWs on Castle Ridge is showing signs of decline. Please send a technician to diagnose the cause and provide appropriate treatment.



Proposals

 Juniper – Please provide a proposal to replace the dead plumbago shrub in the front bed along Hidden Creek on the east side, with one full 3-gallon Plumbago Auriculata 'Imperial Blue' (or, with a better suited cultivar for this area) and to top off the area with pine bark mulch. (Pic 1)



2. Juniper to provide a proposal with two options: (1) to completely remove this dead live oak on the pond bank. Replace hole with fill dirt and new Bahia sod. (2) to remove this live oak and replace with a new 2" caliper live oak. This option must include the construction of an earthen berm 8" -10" tall surrounding the rootball as well as a 30 Gal. Gator Bag with a working flood bubbler (if available) attached to the top of the bag to fill the bag every time the irrigation runs. (Pic 2)



3. Following up on the proposal with Juniper, please provide a proposal to reshape the turf edge in this dead area into clean, straight lines, allowing for the installation of new Bahia turf squares at grade. The new turf should be installed flush with the concrete for a seamless appearance. (Pic 3)
