1) Pasco County Department of Health (DOH) Freshwater Bathing Places Monitoring

Pasco County has provided freshwater bathing water quality results for the month of May.

Location Organisms¹
East Lake Park 24
Lake Padgett Beach 69.5

¹Number of organisms per 100 ml of water, 0-199 Good, Greater than 200 Poor

Water quality at the District's beaches continues to be very good. There has been a significant increase in the quantity of organisms found, probably due to the increases in temperature while entering the summer season. However, the water quality continues to be very good.

As well as general lawn and weed maintenance janitorial duties clerical work, and meeting with residents for new decals gate keys the following maintenance repairs have been completed from 5/7/21-to date. Cut up and removed large fallen limb from lake Joyce park. Contacted two gutter companies for gutter replacement at Kaminski Park. Treated long lake for yellow primose and torpedo grass. Contacted frontier for phone outages at Saxon and stable ridge entrances. Cut back sections of aquatic overgrowth on long lake met with arborist at Lake Joyce and Padgett parks. At the stables dug up bathroom septic line to unblock toilets. Pressure washed cabanas and bathroom blocks at laird and Padgett parks.at Padgett Park removed rotted out deck boards and stringer off one of the two docks, And Started installing new stringers. Set gate times at Padgett Park for ski show and movie night. Met with Pam Carr for walkthrough of parks. Installed new treks decking to one of the two docks at Padgett Park Took work truck in for service and rear brakes. Raked beach areas at Padgett and laird parks.

Lake Padgett Estates Independent Special District

Policy for new boat docks located on LPEISD lake bottom as per adoption by LPEISD Board of Supervisors on September 19, 2017, Board meeting:

- 1. Applicant must have all appropriate county and state (SWFWMD or FLDEP) permits in hand prior to requesting a "Letter of Permission" from the LPEISD Board of Supervisors;
- 2. Applicant must submit their request to LPEISD property management company along with a copy of the dock plans and all permits obtained by Applicant;
- 3. Once the request has been made to the LPEISD property management company the matter shall be scheduled for review and approval at a future LPEISD monthly meeting;
- 4. If approved by the LPEISD Board (majority vote) Applicant shall be required to provide to LPEISD property management company "a declaration sheet insuring LPEISD as an additional insured for the dock" prior to commencing any dock construction on LPEISD property.

Additional terms for Board's consideration (5/20/2021)

- 5. Any requests to LPEISD for a "Letter of Permission" for dock construction must be submitted in writing thirty (30) days prior to LPEISD Board review and consideration*;
- 6. Applicant's request must be in writing with a complete set of dock plans and all county and state permits that have been obtained by Applicant;
- Failure of Applicant to provide a copy of the Pasco County Building permit for the dock construction with Applicant's request shall be deemed an incomplete request and will be rejected automatically by the LPEISD property management company;
- 8. Any approval of the submitted dock plans by the LPEISD Board of Supervisors will be in strict compliance with County and State permits. No revisions or alterations will be approved;
- 9. Failure of the Applicant to construct the dock in strict compliance with approved plans shall result in the immediate withdrawal and termination of LPEISD approval;
- 10. Once approved, and construction of the dock completed, the Applicant, and all future owners of the benefited lot, shall be required to maintain LPEISD as a co-insured and maintain the dock in a safe condition and in conformity with the original construction permit.
- 11. Failure of the Applicant, or future owners of the benefited lot, to maintain the dock in good repair shall result in the automatic withdrawal of LPEISD's prior Letter of Permission and revocation of this license agreement.

- 12. Issuance of a "Letter of Permission" by the LPEISD Board of Supervisors shall not result, or be construed, as a grant of easement or the conveyance of a property interest from LPEISD to the Applicant. The Letter of Permission is merely a license for which LPEISD reserves the right to revoke if Applicant, or any future owners of the benefitted lot, fail to abide the terms of the Letter of Permission.
- Note: This will allow adequate time for LPEISD District Engineer and District Legal Counsel to review the plans and the permits prior to the Board's consideration
