A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PRESERVE AT WILDERNESS LAKE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT DESIGNATING DATES, TIME AND LOCATION FOR REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE DISTRICT, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE







Analysis and Consideration of ADA Website Remediation Proposals

Mr. Huber invited the Board to join Ms. Dobson in the video display area to participate the vendors in the video conference.

Mr. Saul from Campus Suites spoke to his firms experience and reviewed the proposal to ensure that the District meets all of the ADA requirements. He assured the Board that all documents will be uploaded in a timely manner, the website will have a certificate, and indemnification is provided. The CDD will maintain ownership of all content. Pricing was reviewed for remediation of 1500 pages with an additional \$1.05 per page for any additional 100 pages.

The Board sought and received confirmation that photos and the District calendar can be included on the website, PDF documents with handwriting on them can be converted to meet ADA requirements, and they would be willing to work with the District to establish a bulk remediation rate should the District opt to include all individual invoices in the agenda packet.

Mr. Huber reviewed District Counsel's memo regarding the legal website requirements to meet both ADA and Statutory requirements, as well as the timing for completion of the project.

Mr. Horelick reviewed the proposal from ADASC outlining the services to be provided and pricing options. He emphasized that the remediation provided by ADASC is 100% DOJ compliant and other firms to not go to this level. A basic set up package would cost \$2,799 and the Premium package \$5,000; both options would be \$2,000 a year for preparing and uploading documents. He noted that complex PDF documents would cost \$3.95 per page to remediate and Plat maps \$2.90. Pdfs with handwriting on them would incur a higher page price than the standard \$1.00 per page.

 The Board sought and received confirmation that photos and the District calendar can be included on the website, ownership of website content belongs to the CDD while the website theme would be the property of ADASC, ADASC would work with District and new website provider to migrate content from the prior on at a small fee, there should be no issues with storing a years' worth of information on the website, it is possible to include a mobile option of the website with minor deviations.

Board discussion was held regarding the pros and cons of both proposals and the following Board action taken.

On a Motion by Mr. Weissing seconded by Mr. Diver, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved the proposal from Campus Suites for website remediation services, for the Preserve at Wilderness Lake Community Development District.
