#### **Never Feed Alligators**

Feeding alligators, whether intentionally or unintentionally is not only <u>illegal and potentially a felony</u>, it's dangerous to the animal itself. Most alligators that are under 4' in length pose no risk to humans or pets, unless handled. When fed, alligators can overcome their natural wariness and learn to associate people with food. When this happens, some of these alligators have to be removed and killed. Dispose of fish bait in garbage cans at the dock or inside your home. Do not ever throw them, or any meat into the water. Although you are not intentionally feeding alligators when you do this, the result can be the same.

#### **Never Feed Sandhill Cranes**

People may inadvertently put sandhill cranes at risk when they attract them with feed. This includes "accidental feeding," such as when bird seed is spilled from bird feeders onto the ground below. In 2002, the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission made it illegal to intentionally feed sandhill cranes. When cranes are fed and learn to associate people with food, they can lose their fear of humans. These "habituated" cranes may approach people closely and even grab food out of a person's hand. In rare instances, cranes have been reported pecking people.

In Florida, any feeding, intentional or otherwise, of bears, coyotes, foxes, raccoons, pelicans, **alligators**, crocodiles, **sandhill cranes**, and wild monkeys is illegal and subject to civil penalties.

## COCA COLA WINGS

#### **WILDERNESS VERSION**

What a fun use of soda, pop, coke, cola... whatever your regional name is for the bubbly brown stuff. As huge fans of good wings, my household loves this recipe. It's quick, fun and SO TASTY!

## SHOPPING LIST & DIRECTIONS

2 LBS CHICKEN WINGS
2 TBSP MILD OIL (LIKE CANOLA OR VEGETABLE)
3 SLICES OF GINGER
1 CAN COLA (REGULAR)
1 TBSP WHITE WINE
3 TBSP SOY SAUCE
1 PIECE OF DRIED ORANGE PEEL
1 SMALL CINNAMON STICK

- Wash and clean the chicken wings. Cut the wings at the joint and pat the chicken with a paper towel.
- Preheat the wok or cast-iron pan. Add the oil and spread to coat the bottom.
   Now, add the ginger and the chicken wings. Spread out the wing pieces in a single layer, and lightly brown them for a few minutes on each side over high heat.
- Add the cola, wine, soy sauce and orange peel and cinnamon stick. Bring to a boil, cover and reduce heat to medium. Let simmer for 12-15 minutes until the sauce thickens.
- Finally, Stir the wings and add salt to taste. Increase heat to carmelize remaining sauce and coat the wings and serve.



#### A NAME FOR ALL THE AGES

November's name has remained unchanged since the ancient Roman calendar, which was in use until 45BC. The first Roman calendar was only made up of ten months, with November being the ninth. November translates rather appropriately into "ninth month" in Latin. When the Julian calendar was adopted in 45BC, two new months were added, which pushed November back to the 11th month. Despite it's change in position, The month of November was never renamed.




#### **BEAVER MOON**


