# WHAT TO BRING TO THE SPLASH PAD

Hello neighbors from the Johnson family! Our family has enjoyed living here for eight years and the highlight of our summers at the Lodge is the Splash Pad. We truly love the ability to walk in and enjoy an amenity designed around the younger residents. A few items that you may want to bring along:

- Waterproof sunscreen
- One towel per child
- Water Shoes (to keep slipping down to a minimum)
- Bandages just in case, although there is a first aid kit available right at the pool

# The Best Avocado Deviled Eggs

## **Tips from the Test Kitchen**

Expert advice and tips straight from EatingWell's Test Kitchen

- 1. If you want a smoother filling, push the egg yolk mixture through a fine-mesh sieve to remove any clumps.
- 2. Add 2 teaspoons finely chopped chipotle in adobo for a spicy kick.
- To make peeling freshly hard-boiled eggs easier, crack each one on the side of the pot then submerge them in ice water to cool. This step helps release the cooked eggs from their shells.

# **Ingredients**

- 6 large hard-boiled eggs, peeled and halved lengthwise
- 1 small avocado, halved and peeled
- 3 tablespoons thinly sliced fresh chives, divided
- · 2 tablespoons light mayonnaise
- 1 tablespoon lime juice
- 1 teaspoon Dijon mustard
- 1/4 teaspoon paprika
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 2 tablespoons cooked 1/4-inch strips center-cut bacon (from 1 slice; optional)
- 11/2 tablespoons sliced pickled red onions
- Crushed red pepper for garnish (optional)

## **Directions**

- Carefully remove egg yolks from egg whites using a spoon; place the yolks in a medium bowl. Place egg white halves on a large plate.
- Add avocado, 2 tablespoons chives, mayonnaise, lime juice, mustard, paprika and salt to the bowl with the egg yolks. Mix and mash thoroughly with a fork until smooth.
- 3. Spoon the egg yolk mixture evenly into each egg white half (about 1 tablespoon each). (Alternatively, place the egg yolk mixture in a pastry bag, or a zip-top bag with a 1/4-inch corner cut off, and pipe the filling into the egg white halves.)
- 4. Garnish each egg half with bacon (if using), pickled red onions and the remaining 1 tablespoon chives. Sprinkle with crushed red pepper, if desired.

# SANDHILL CRANES (FACTS, INFO, PICTURES)

Perhaps you have heard them flying overhead, bugling loudly as they migrate in the classic V-shape. Or maybe you have seen hundreds, or even thousands of them gathering in a marsh. Anywhere you spot them, these large cranes grab your attention. The Sandhill Crane, named for its preference of habitat, migrates in flocks of such numbers than many states have festivals to mark their arrival. In this article we will learn more about these elegant birds, and answer many of the most frequently asked questions about sandhill cranes.

- Height: 2.7 ft. 4.6 ft.
- Weight: Males average 10 lbs., females average 8.9 lbs.
- Wingspan: 5.5 ft. 7.7 ft.

### **OVERVIEW**

Adults are gray overall with some tan feathers on their stocky body. They have a long neck, black beak, black legs, and bright read forehead. Males and females have identical plumage and have no visible differences. Immature cranes lack the bright red crown and have a more "rusty" color, and can have more streaked rusty colored feathers on their body.

### NESTING AND BREEDING

Sandhill cranes choose their mating partner, which they will stay with for life, based on elaborate dancing displays. The pair can jump, bow, bob their head, flap their wings, and even pickup and toss vegetation. They do continue this dancing behavior even past the breeding season.

These cranes breed in wetlands and other habitats where there is standing water. They build a nest mound out of vegetation on the ground or in the shallow water. One to three eggs are laid but often only one chick reaches fledgling age. Chicks will remain under the care of their parents for 9-10 months.











# **Reminders for Spring & Summer Fun**

Pool season is upon us, and the pools are a great place to unwind and enjoy a relaxing BBQ with your family and friends. Upon arriving at the pool, you will notice a pool attendant stationed at the front gate. The pool attendant will ask to see your Lodge Access Card ID; at that point you will sign in yourself, family and guests. After signing in, the pool attendant will issue you a wrist band. The wrist band must be worn at all times. This process ensures compliance with the Board mandated Aquatics rules. (Pool attendant on staff March – September).

POOLS & JACUZZI CLOSE AT DUSK EACH NIGHT.

NO FOOD OR BEVERAGES WITHIN 10 FEET OF POOLS.

SHOWER BEFORE ENTERING THE POOLS OR JACUZZI.

SMOKING IS PROHIBITED.

GLASS CONTAINERS ARE PROHIBITED.

ANYONE UNDER THE AGE OF 12 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT.

NO RECREATIONAL FLOATATION DEVICES IN THE POOLS.

RESIDENTS AGES 12 - 17 ARE ALLOWED ONE GUEST WITH PARENTAL PERMISSION.

GUESTS MUST BE AT LEAST 12 YEARS OF AGE.

RESIDENTS AGES 12 - 17 MUST CHECK IN WITH THE LODGE STAFF AND OBTAIN A WRISTBAND UPON ARRIVAL AT THE LODGE.

KID'S ACCESS WRISTBANDS ARE NOW AVAILABLE FOR KIDS AGES 12-15 YEARS OF AGE.
THE WRISTBANDS WILL ALLOW DIRECT ACCESS TO THE POOLS AND TENNIS COURTS.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT IS IN PLACE TO MEET FL. STATUTES AND SHOULD NOT BE USED FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES.


