# Cheesecake Stuffed Strawberries


- 2 pounds of fresh strawberries, washed
- 8 ounce package cream cheese, softened to room temperature
- ½ cup powdered sugar
- 🤎 1 tablespoon heavy whipping cream
- 📁 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ¼ cup graham cracker crumbs
- 1. Slice off the green stems of the strawberries so that they sit flat with the "stem" side, facing down.
- 2. On the other end of the strawberry (narrow end) cut an "X" from the tip through part of the base, but make sure to not slice all the way through or your strawberries will fall apart. Repeat with the remaining strawberries and set aside.
- 3. In a large mixing bowl, beat the cream cheese with an electric mixer until smooth.
- 4. Add the powdered sugar, cream and vanilla to the cream cheese and beat until well combined.
- 5. Once mixed together, fill a pastry bag with a tip, or plastic ziptop bag (such as a Ziploc bag) with the end cut off.
- 6. Pipe the cream cheese filling into the center of each sliced strawberry, filling it up all the way.
- 7. Sprinkle each strawberry with a bit of graham cracker crumbs.
- 8. Chill in the refrigerator for one hour or until ready to serve. Enjoy!
