FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS

Call to Order

Mr. Moore called the meeting to order and conducted roll call.

SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS

Audience Comments

 A resident raised concerns over the Board considering funding for Pond Remediation without having received proposals for the work and expressed disagreement with the Board considering amendment to landscape cost share agreement.

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THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Staff Reports

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A. District Counsel

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1. Discussion Regarding Status of Pond Remediation Financing

District Counsel reviewed Center State Bank Non-Binding Proposal and noted an error in proposal that discussion was not to exceed \$900,000.00 yet the wording states \$800,000.00. The figure was based on the District Engineer's estimates and approving this proposal will put the District in a position to move forward once Pond Remediation proposals are received.

On a Motion by Mr. Fondario, seconded by Mr. Litrenta, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors authorized the chair to execute term sheet, for the Copperstone Community Development District.

Mr. Cohen informed the board that the Governor's Executive Order expires November 1, 2020.

B. District Engineer

1. Review of Drainage Report

Mr. Schappacher investigated drainage concern behind property at 7911 113th Avenue Circle East and found no issue in the area that needed to be addressed.

2. Consideration of Erosion Repair Proposal

Mr. Schappacher informed the Board that the RFP for Erosion Repair has been published and questions are due by October 23rd. Bid submissions are required by end of day November 5th, 10 vendors are currently considering placing a bid.

Mr. Schappacher updated the Board that the phase 1 recertification has been completed with SWFWMD.

Mr. Schlotzhauer raised a question regarding planting in areas of ponds to comply with SWFWMD.

C. Aquatic Services

1. Presentation of Restoration Assessments

Mr. Jasczak informed the Board that the plantings in ponds #1, 4, 5, 8, 10, 11, 13 & 21-25 started today and are expected to be completed Thursday.

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2. Consideration of Aluminum Sulfate Services Agreement

The Board reviewed the Pond 20 restoration assessment. Mr. Jasczak recommend Aluminum Sulfate treatment and a proposal for aeration should be considered.

On a Motion by Ms. Tran, seconded by Mr. Fondario, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved the proposal from Solitude for aluminum sulfate treatment for the Copperstone Community Development District.

D. District Manager

Mr. Moore informed the Board that the next regular meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, November 17, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. and is currently planned to be held in person.

Mr. Moore distributed the RFP for pedestrian bridge repairs to five vendors and requested guidance from Board regarding the need to replace railings. The Board preferred to focus on decking and straps only.
