74 poles. Duke does not do any landscaping but they would require prior approval of any  
75 plantings in this area. Once the turnover has occurred the Board would like a plan on  
76 what and when they could install new plantings. The Board requested that Mr. Brown get  
77 pricing from LMP for plantings on CDD owned ponds.

99  
100 Mr. Babbar provided an update to the Board regarding the access path from State  
101 Road 56 into the Windsor community. He explained that the County reported to him that  
102 the County did not intend to complete a connection at that point. The Board members  
103 discussed the access issue, the status of the existing easement and discussed potential  
104 options to consider for the area to prevent individuals from entering there.  
105 Recommendations for consideration is to stop maintaining the area, putting up a fence or  
106 installing landscaping. The Board discussed the need to coordinate information with the  
107 HOA, since they own the area, and to gather information from the HOA with regards to  
108 options they would prefer for possible restriction of the access. Mr. Babbar noted that  
109 any fencing installation would require a permit from the County.

110

114 Mr. Stewart updated the Board regarding the obligation of maintaining the wildlands  
115 to evaluate and report but explained that there apparently was little to no real

118 cleanup to maintain compliance. Ms. Stewart will provide an update to the Board after  
119 she discusses with an independent environmental consultant.

Ms. Stewart indicated that she will check on drainage issues in the Shellwood community and report back to the Board.

D. Amenity Management

The Board received an Amenity Management update from Mr. Anaya. The Board reviewed a proposal from Southern Automated for miscellaneous parts for the gate that the District can purchase and stock on-site so they will be available when needed.

On a Motion by Ms. Sholl, seconded by Ms. Fischer, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved the Southern Automated proposal for parts to be stored on-site at a not-to-exceed amount of \$6,496.00, for the Meadow Pointe IV Community Development District.

Mr. Anaya opened a discussion of re-opening the facilities. Mr. Babbar Stated most county facilities have remained closed and advised when they do open the need to have staff and the necessary sanitation supplies. Mr. Raul and Mr. Gruhl will put together a plan for re-opening and present to the Board that will include staff and materials for their review.
