

# Landscape Committee Charter

## **Landscape Committee Mission Statement:**

The Waterlefe Golf & River Club Landscape Committee's mission is to advise the CDD Board on the management and maintenance of the community's landscape in common areas and roadways. We work to preserve the beauty of the neighborhood while also being cost effective. As members of the community, we understand the significance of creating beautiful landscaping and the added value it brings.

## **Responsibilities & Scope:**

The CDD Landscape Committee is responsible for preserving and enhancing the landscaping in many of the public areas in Waterlefe. Recent projects include renovating the landscaping in the Waterlefe Boulevard median, in the median islands that lead into our neighborhoods, in the roundabout, and the quarterly rotation of annuals that brighten our community. The committee also managed the renovation and installation of entrance monuments at Upper Manatee River Road, the Winding Stream Gate and the Mossy Branch Gate. We have many more exciting projects planned in the months ahead.

The CDD Landscape Committee does not oversee the landscaping on the golf course, The Shores, the condos or The River Club. The latter is managed by the MPOA.

The Committee is made up of six resident volunteers and a CDD Board Liaison. We identify landscaping issues and projects, and make recommendations to the CDD Board, which has final authority over which projects move forward.

## **Meeting Schedule:**

The Committee meets once a month in the Lefe Room at Waterlefe, typically at 2pm on the first Friday of each month. The meetings are open to the public, and we encourage community input.
