15 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA,**
16 **ESTABLISHING THE EASTON PARK COMMUNITY**
17 **DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT; FOR THE PURPOSE OF**
18 **MANAGING AND DELIVERING BASIC COMMUNITY**
19 **INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN A PARCEL OF**
20 **LAND GENERALLY LOCATED OFF MORRIS BRIDGE ROAD,**
21 **APPROXIMATELY 1 MILE SOUTH OF THE PASCO AND**
22 **HILLSBOROUGH COUNTY LINE (COMPRISING 343.71 ACRES**
23 **MORE OR LESS); ENTIRELY WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF**
24 **THE CITY OF TAMPA, HILLSBOROUGH COUNTY, FLORIDA;**
25 **THE SAME BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN**
26 **SECTION 2 HEREOF; PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 190, FLORIDA**
27 **STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN**
28 **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

32 **A. WHEREAS, K-TAMPA LLC AND KRUSEN-DOUGLAS LLC (collectively the**
33 **"Petitioner") have submitted a petition with the City Council of the City of Tampa, Florida**
34 **(the "City") pursuant to the Uniform Community Development District Act of 1980,**
35 **Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, to adopt an ordinance to establish a community development**
36 **district ("CDD"), and designating the land area for which the CDD would manage and**
37 **finance the delivery of basic infrastructure services; and**

39 **B. WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 190 Florida Statutes the City conducted a**
40 **public hearing to consider oral and written comments on the petition; and**

42 **C. WHEREAS, the proposed CDD complies with the requirements of law, is in the**
43 **best interest and promotes the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of**
44 **Tampa;**

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the recitals above are hereby incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. That the **Easton Park Community Development District** is hereby authorized and established, the administration of which shall be subject to the provisions of Chapter 190 Florida Statutes, as amended from time to time; and, the boundaries of which are more particularly described below:

See Attached Exhibit "A"

Section 3. That the five (5) initial members of the Board of Supervisors are:

- (a) Mr. James Bagley
- (b) Mr. James Blackburn
- (c) Ms. Theresa Collins
- (d) Ms. Tonja Stewart
- (e) Mr. Lee Thompson.

Section 4. That all statements contained within the petition have been found to be true and correct.

Section 5. That establishment of the CDD is consistent with the applicable elements and portions of the state comprehensive plan and the effective City of Tampa comprehensive plan.

Section 6. That the area of land within the approved CDD is of sufficient size, is sufficiently compact, and is sufficiently contiguous to be developable as one functional interrelated community.

Section 7. That the approved CDD is the best alternative available for delivering community development services and facilities to the area that will be served by the District.

Section 8. That the services and facilities of the approved CDD will be compatible with the capacity and uses of existing local and regional community development services and facilities.

Section 9. That the area that will be served by the district is amenable to separate special-district government.

Section 10. That the approved CDD shall be responsible for design, permitting,

1 installation and maintenance obligations of all essential infrastructure facilities in the
2 manner described in **Exhibit F** to the petition to establish the Easton Park Community
3 Development District, a copy of which is attached hereto.

4
5 Section 11. That the approved CDD is hereby granted authority to assess ad
6 valorem taxes for non-bond service operating purposes up to the statutory maximum of 5 mills.

7
8 Section 12. That the approved CDD is hereby granted authority to exercise
9 those certain Special Powers enumerated in Chapter 190.012 (2) (a-f) Florida Statutes.

10
11 Section 13. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, provision, or part
12 of this ordinance shall be invalid for any reason, the remainder of this ordinance shall not
13 be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

14
15 Section 14. That the Petitioner, at Petitioners sole cost and expense, shall file a
16 certified copy of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida and
17 forward acknowledgement to the City Clerk that a copy of the Ordinance has been duly
18 filed. Upon receipt of the acknowledgment from Petitioner, the City Clerk shall certify
19 and record a copy of this Ordinance in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of
20 Hillsborough County, Florida. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon
21 recording with the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Hillsborough County, Florida.
