Continual stocking of the ponds with fish that thrive on Hydrilla is encouraged, as the results provide positive indication of declining levels of Hydrilla over the last couple of months.

Trimming of the ornamental grasses began the week of September 19th.



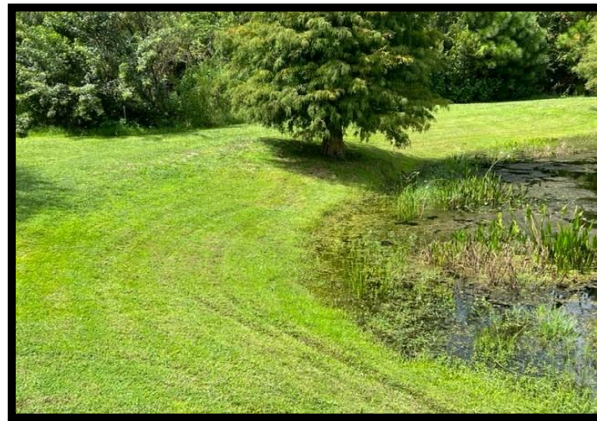

The Foxtail pool landscape enhancement is taking shape. The Board may want to consider adding small plant material along the borders of the pool deck at a later date.



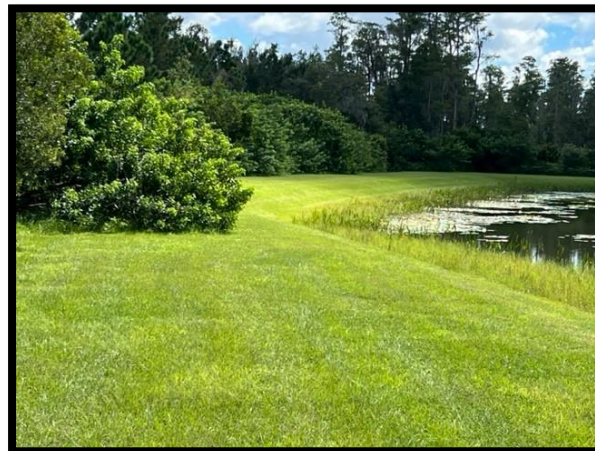


The Community Garden is taking shape with a new crop of Tomatoes, Green & Red Peppers, and Broccoli.

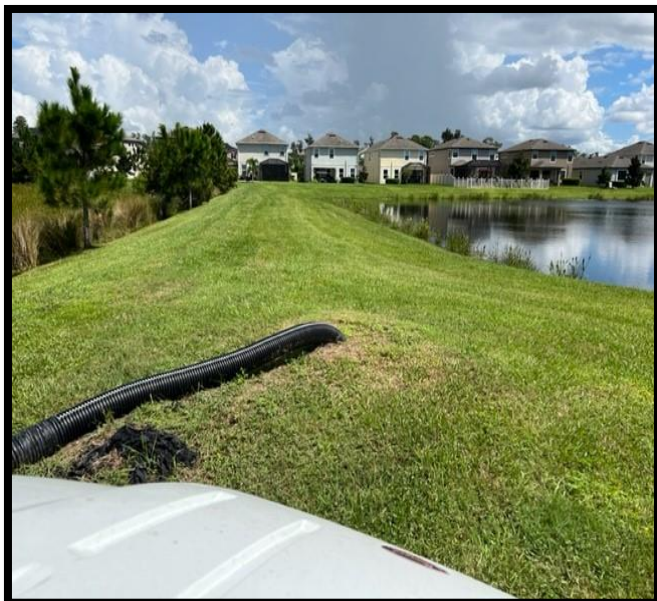
Recommendations

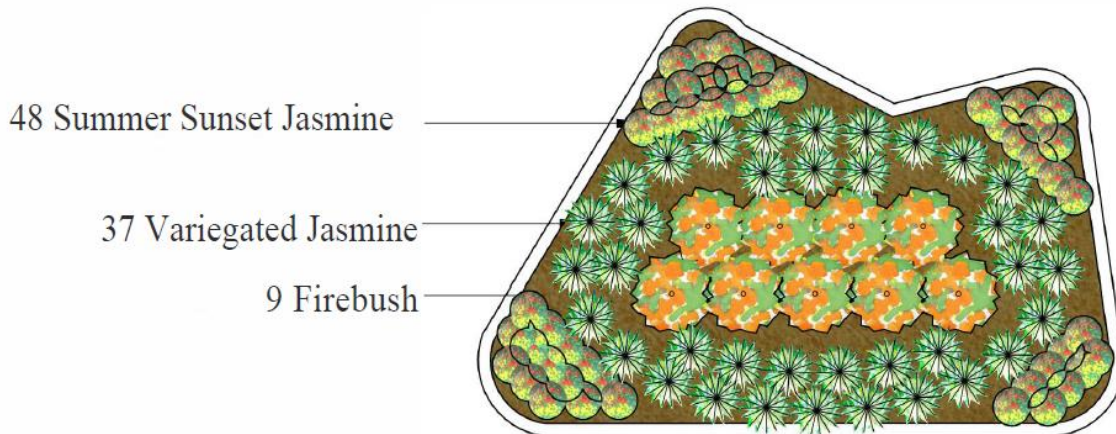

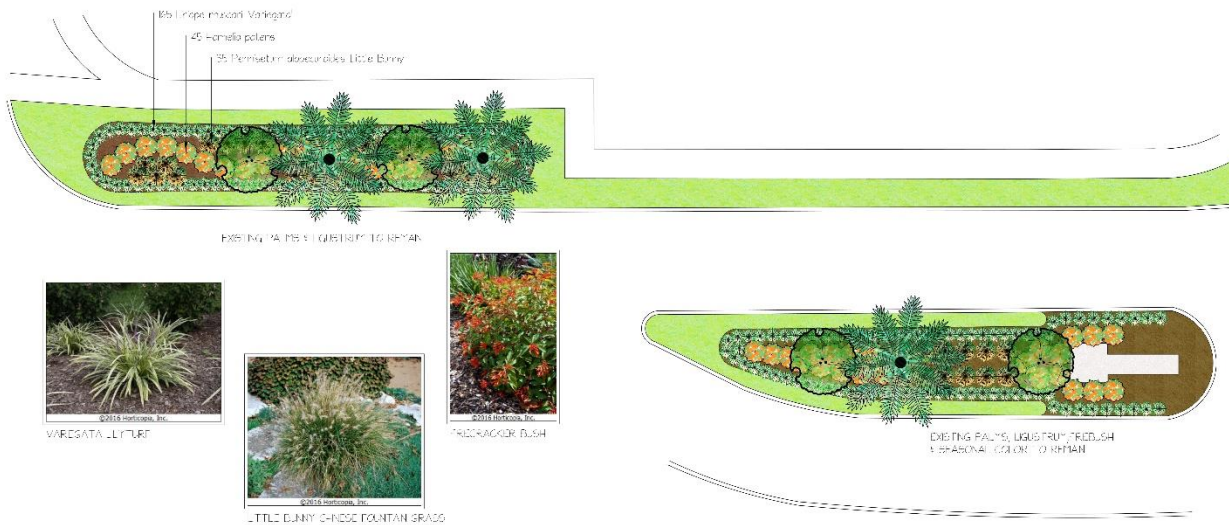

24 **SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS – Audience Comments – (limited to 3 minutes per individual for**
25 *agenda items)*

26 Prior to opening the floor to audience comments, Ms. Clawson led all present in reciting the Pledge
27 of Allegiance.

28 There being none, the next item followed.

29 **THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS – Staff Reports**

30 A. Landscaping & Irrigation

31 1. Exhibit 1: Presentation of August Field Inspection Report

32 There were no comments on the Field Inspection Report.

33 2. Exhibit 2: RedTree Proposals (if any)

- 34 • Entrance Island & Inbound Planting Bed - \$9,210.00
- 35 • Island End Cap Renovation - \$2,467.25
- 36 • End Cap Renovation - \$2,579.00

37 Ms. Dobson stated that RedTree was not able to attend the meeting to present the proposals,
38 and asked the Board whether they wished to discuss the proposals or to table them for
39 further consideration. The Board discussed conditions of islands around the traffic circle,
40 and the potentials of various plant material. Ms. Clawson stated that she had discussed the
41 matter with Ms. Dobson, and had agreed to work through the project to determine

42 alternative plans and suggestions, given that the plants may not be the best fit. Mr. Twomey
43 inquired about uses for the carryover at the start of the next fiscal year, and Ms. Dobson
44 advised that extra funds could go into the next year's capital improvement plan, or could
45 be rolled into reserves. Comments were made about crew staffing potentially being spread
46 thin, and Mr. Henman additionally discussed the process of detailing the community, by
47 breaking sections out for rotations.

48 The Board discussed contractual obligations for the landscape team, including palm
49 trimming, fertilization, and rotations. Mr. Pellan encouraged the Board to review the scope
50 of services in the agreement, suggesting that the requirements of the agreement were not
51 currently being fulfilled. Mr. Pellan stated that there was a clause in the agreement to repair
52 obligations that had not been fulfilled within 48 hours, and failure to comply and address
53 these again would result in a violation of the agreement.

54 Mr. Koford made a motion, seconded by Mr. Smith, to take the landscape contract out to
55 bid, for the Long Lake Ranch Community Development District.

56 During discussion of the motion, Ms. Sandy advised that the District would need to
57 undergo a formal RFP process, and fielded questions from the Board regarding costs and
58 criteria. Ms. Dobson also cautioned against the Board going out for RFP for the same
59 services in quick succession, as this may dissuade vendors from submitting proposals. Mr.
60 Koford clarified that he had made his motion out of concern for the vendor's capacity,
61 acknowledging that the vendor was professional and communicative, and had otherwise
62 been capable of doing work properly.

63 During discussion of the motion, Ms. Clawson asked for clarification on the tree pruning
64 monthly task, and Mr. Henman explained that tree pruning and hardwood pruning were
65 considered separate services. Mr. Koford additionally indicated that there was a dead pine
66 tree by Sun Lake Boulevard, and a declining elm in the area.

67 During discussion of the motion, Mr. Pellan suggested that it was the District management
68 company's responsibility to ensure that companies under contract with the CDD were
69 meeting the requirements and expectations, and fulfilling the specified scopes of service.
70 Ms. Dobson acknowledged this and indicated that communications between DPFG staff
71 and the landscape company were well documented.

72 During discussion of the motion, Ms. Sandy stated that she had the documentation and the
73 criteria that the Board used for the previous RFP, and could go through them with the
74 Board. Ms. Sandy stated that moving forward with the RFP would need authorization of
75 District staff to notice the RFP and assemble the project manual, as well as approval from
76 the Board of the evaluation criteria. Ms. Dobson suggested having a meeting between
77 District staff and Mr. Lucadano to lay out the contract and go through with each point,
78 making the Board's expectations for landscaping and perceived shortcomings clear. Ms.
79 Dobson suggested having a 30-day window to get everything back in line, else the District
80 would then go out for RFP. Ms. Sandy commented that the Board could additionally
81 authorize for a Supervisor to work directly on this issue.

82 Ms. Dobson stated that, as the discussion of going out to bid was not on the agenda, the
83 Board needed to open the floor to public comment.

84 Comments were made from residents regarding the need for the vendor to fulfill the
85 number of site visits and services paid for by the contract.

86 Following the public comment period, Mr. Koford withdrew his motion.

87 Mr. Koford explained that his withdrawal of the motion was contingent upon a meeting
88 occurring between District management staff and the landscape vendor, and asked whether
89 the Board could send a list of concerns. Ms. Dobson stated that she recommended
90 representation from the Board as this would lend weight to the list of concerns being raised
91 by the Board. Ms. Dobson suggested for Supervisors to send in their concerns by
92 September 6, and then she would proceed with scheduling a meeting at the clubhouse with
93 herself, Mr. Henman, Mr. Lucadano, Mr. Koford, and, if possible, Mr. Johnson, to go
94 through the list. Ms. Dobson added that she would send copies of the current agreement
95 to the Board for reference.

96 *(Mr. Smith left the meeting at 6:57 p.m. and rejoined at 6:59 p.m.)*

97 Two irrigation proposals were walked on, in the amounts of \$2,217.50 and \$7,017.50, with
98 Ms. Dobson explaining that these were in response to a recent lightning strike. Ms. Dobson
99 stated that the first estimate was to replace the Hunter I-Core controller and output module,
100 as currently it was causing the irrigation to constantly run, and that the second was an
101 alternative to install a full easy-to-wire decoder system with associated modules and
102 connectors. Discussion ensued.

103 On a MOTION by Mr. Koford, SECONDED by Mr. Smith, WITH ALL IN FAVOR, the Board approved
104 the irrigation proposal for replacement of the Hunter I-Core controller and output module, in the amount of
105 \$2,217.50, for the Long Lake Ranch Community Development District.

106 Following the motion, Ms. Dobson suggested proceeding with the Illuminations Holiday
107 Lighting agenda item, as the vendor was present at the meeting.

108 B. Exhibit 9: Consideration of Illuminations Holiday Lighting Proposal - \$13,900.00

109 **This item was presented out of order.**

110 Mr. Gay explained the scope of the existing basic proposal, and noted that it was itemized
111 for the Board to be able to pick and choose which aspects they wished to have for the
112 community. The Board commented on Mr. Gay presented a track lighting product as an
113 alternative to the proposal, noting that it would be a one-time cost to install it permanently
114 as a year-round lighting feature. Comments were made by the Board stating that while they
115 were positive on the product, there was not currently room on the budget. Ms. Clawson
116 additionally noted that the CDD had purchased lights in 2021 that were currently in storage
117 at Foxtail.

118 In response to a question from the District Manager, Mr. Gay stated that he had worked
119 with communities that had purchased the track lighting for one or two structures at a time,
120 and that he was open to however the District may want to prioritize structures. Mr. Gay
121 fielded questions from the Board regarding troubleshooting lighting, durability during
122 storms, and remote access to control the lighting.

123 Ms. Dobson distributed an estimate from Florida Field Services, which was the vendor who
124 had installed lighting for the community in 2021, and stated that reinstallation from them
125 came out to \$4,450.00. Discussion ensued regarding the amount of bulbs that had been
126 purchased previously, and what costs would be to address bulbs that were burnt out or
127 broken.

128 Following discussion, Ms. Dobson stated that she could bring consideration of this item
129 back to the next meeting, with other options to explore, and that staff could get a count of
130 how many lights were currently nonfunctional to get estimated pricing for replacements.

131 Ms. Dobson introduced Mr. Butler to the Board, and Mr. Henman explained the context of
132 the verbal proposal to power wash the fence by the lake being presented. Mr. Butler stated
133 that his bottom-line price for the length of the fence was \$1,400. The Board discussed and
134 determined that there was money in the budget to pay for this.

135 Ms. Dobson noted that another community had similarly needed to deal with rust issues,
136 and that sealing the panels following cleaning had been an effective preventative measure
137 that also made subsequent cleaning easier. The Board discussed sealant solutions, including
138 a locally produced product named Snowcap, and comments were made in favor of treating
139 a small test area.

140 Mr. Smith made a motion, seconded by Mr. Koford, to approve the American Power
141 Washing lake fence pressure washing proposal, in an amount not to exceed \$1,400.00.

142 During discussion of the motion, Ms. Dobson stated that as this item was not on the
143 published agenda, the Board needed to open the floor to public comment before voting on
144 the motion. There were no comments from the public on this item.

145 On a MOTION by Mr. Smith, SECONDED by Mr. Koford, WITH ALL IN FAVOR, the Board approved
146 the American Power Washing lake fence pressure washing proposal, in an amount not to exceed \$1,400.00,
147 for the Long Lake Ranch Community Development District.

148 Following the motion, Mr. Butler stated that he could get a written copy of the proposal to
149 Ms. Dobson the day following the meeting.

150 C. Aquatic Services

151 1. Exhibit 3: Presentation of Aquatics Treatment Report

152 Mr. Henman noted that the aquatic services vendor was in the process of getting a hydrilla
153 outbreak under control, adding that erosion had also been noticed by Dagger Wing. Mr.
154 Pellan recalled previous discussions about a hydrilla killer treatment, and Ms. Dobson
155 stated that the vendor had been waiting to see how the fish would respond prior to applying
156 additional spray treatments, but that she could follow up with him.

157 Mr. Henman additionally gave an overview of field operations, noting that speed limit signs
158 were now being installed, and reporting some issues with the south fountain related to
159 electrical problems that the vendor was working to resolve. Mr. Henman addressed
160 Supervisor questions about the shed, stating that it would be installed as soon as the
161 concrete was in. Ms. Dobson added that the CDD had placed a 50% down payment for the
162 project, and that the remaining funds were set aside.

163 The Board discussed the conditions of the gates, with comments made indicating the
164 maintenance and repair costs, as well as the downtime. The Board discussed the possibility
165 of removing the gates, and District Counsel was requested to look into legal considerations.
166 The Board additionally directed staff to acquire proposals and provide recommendations
167 for heavy duty fence and gate replacement.

168 D. District Engineer

169 The District Engineer was not present. Ms. Dobson stated that she had walked the area with Mr.
170 Chang for the new utility shed, and that she had distributed emailed recommendations from him
171 regarding an erosion issue, which the aquatic services vendor was working on a proposal to address.

172 E. District Counsel

173 Ms. Sandy stated that an executed copy of the Board-approved HOA use agreement had been
174 received, following additional work with the HOA counsel. Ms. Sandy additionally provided an
175 update on the letter sent to the residents involved in the July 9 incident at the pool, in which
176 information regarding the temporary suspension of amenity privileges had been relayed. Ms. Sandy
177 advised that she had been notified that the residents were seeking a potential attorney regarding a
178 claim against the CDD for alleged selective enforcement. Ms. Sandy requested for any
179 communications surrounding the incident received by Board members or staff to be directed to her
180 office.

181 Ms. Sandy additionally provided updates on agreements that had been drafted for amenity
182 management and pool cleaning with Vesta, and finalized agreements for concrete and electric
183 vendors. Ms. Sandy also noted that two property access agreements had been put together, one of
184 which had already been approved by the Board and the other of which was on the agenda for
185 consideration.

186 Mr. Koford asked whether there was any action that the Board could take to revise CDD
187 responsibilities for maintaining the landscaping by the construction site near Sun Lake Boulevard,
188 noting that construction trucks were constantly driving across the area anyway. Ms. Sandy stated
189 that the CDD had a license agreement with the county to maintain the landscaping, and that she
190 believed that the District had the ability to terminate the agreement, contingent upon the removal
191 of any landscaping and/or irrigation installed. Ms. Clawson stated that she believed there was none.
192 Ms. Sandy stated that she would need to look at the use agreement, but could draft a letter of
193 termination.

194 On a MOTION by Ms. Clawson, SECONDED by Mr. Koford, WITH ALL IN FAVOR, the Board approved
195 the authorization of District Counsel to draft a letter of termination notifying Pasco County that Long Lake
196 Ranch CDD would cease from maintaining the landscaping along Sun Lake Boulevard from Night Shade
197 to US Highway 54, for the Long Lake Ranch Community Development District.

198 F. Clubhouse Manager

199 1. Exhibit 4: Presentation of Clubhouse Manager Report

200 Mr. Ruhlig stated that the subpanel and rear pavilion piping had been completed by Kazar's
201 Electric, and that they had been asked to provide an estimate for work on the box for the
202 fountain. Mr. Ruhlig stated that the Foxtail pool was now fully operational, but that the
203 transition to the new access control system was still in progress, to be completed within the
204 next two weeks. Mr. Ruhlig noted some minimal surge protection that had gone in for the
205 security system with pool gates, following some lightning damage that had occurred, and
206 that a new surge protector battery backup unit had since been ordered. Following
207 discussion on communicating the Foxtail system transition out to residents, Ms. Dobson
208 suggested that any eblast be emailed out to the Board first ahead of time for their awareness.

209 Mr. Ruhlig added that some of the fans at Foxtail had had motors blow out as part of the
210 electrical issue, and asked the Board whether he could proceed with ordering replacements.
211 The Board did not express any opposition to the suggestion.

212 G. District Manager

213 Ms. Dobson noted that an email had been sent out the day before the meeting, regarding concerns
214 on the budget that had been raised by Supervisor Smith, and noted that she invited Mr. Smith to
215 have a conference call with herself, Mr. McGaffney, and potentially an accountant as clarification.

216 Mr. Smith commented on the approval process of the budget, suggesting that the budget had been
217 unbalanced and rushed through despite there being a viable 15-day window for a notice to have

218 been posted in accordance with the deadline. Mr. Smith expressed concerns about there not being
219 a reserve schedule, noting that he would be working with Mr. McGaffney to put something
220 together. Ms. Dobson clarified that the CDD had a reserve fund and study, and that the balance was
221 something that the Board voted on each year. Mr. Smith additionally expressed concerns about
222 audited financial statements not yet being provided, noting a delay of about 60 days. Ms. Sandy
223 stated that she would need to get an estimated date from Mr. McGaffney, noting that there was an
224 auditing firm that the District Management company worked with for audited financials. Ms.
225 Dobson confirmed that the CDD's auditors had everything, and were sending regular updates on
226 progress.

227 Ms. Dobson noted a request from the HOA for the Board to consider installing a digital lock on the
228 door for the spirit committee to be able to access. The Board discussed methods to have access
229 restricted to various extents. Ms. Dobson added that, in response to unauthorized use of one of the
230 CDD pumps and wells, as well as clock and controller doors being left open, the irrigation vendor
231 had been authorized to install small locks on the controllers.

232 1. Discussion of Sun Lake Blvd. Streetlights

233 Ms. Dobson stated that Pasco County would be responding to the street light situation by
234 the end of the week.

235 **FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS – Consent Agenda**

236 A. Exhibit 5: Consideration of Minutes of the Board of Supervisors' Meetings Held on August 4, 2022

237 Mr. Pellan commented that he felt that Mr. Smith's concerns regarding the budget had not been
238 properly reflected in the minutes. Ms. Clawson suggested that Lines 308-319 adequately
239 summarized Mr. Smith's opposition and the suggested meeting with Mr. McGaffney to reconcile
240 the issues, and that the motion at Lines 332-335 included language related to Mr. Smith working
241 with District staff to ensure accuracy.

242 On a MOTION by Ms. Clawson, SECONDED by Mr. Smith, WITH ALL IN FAVOR, the Board approved
243 the Minutes of the Board of Supervisors' Meetings Held on August 4, 2022, for the Long Lake Ranch
244 Community Development District.

245 B. Exhibit 6: Consideration of Unaudited July 2022 Financial Statements

246 Mr. Twomey asked for clarification on an unassigned balance, and comments were made in favor
247 of looking into reallocating funds once the audit came back.

248 On a MOTION by Ms. Clawson, SECONDED by Mr. Twomey, WITH ALL IN FAVOR, the Board
249 approved the Unaudited July 2022 Financial Statements for the Long Lake Ranch Community Development
250 District.

251 C. Exhibit 7: Consideration of Operation and Maintenance Expenditures for July 2022

252 *(Mr. Smith left the meeting at 9:19 p.m.)*

253 On a MOTION by Mr. Koford, SECONDED by Ms. Clawson, WITH ALL IN FAVOR, the Board approved
254 the Operation and Maintenance Expenditures for July 2022 for the Long Lake Ranch Community
255 Development District.

256 **FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS – Business Items**

257 A. Exhibit 8: Consideration & Adoption of **Resolution 2022-14**, Designating Signatories for
258 Operating Bank Account

259 On a MOTION by Mr. Koford, SECONDED by Mr. Twomey, WITH ALL IN FAVOR, the Board adopted
260 **Resolution 2022-14**, Designating Signatories for Operating Bank Account, for the Long Lake Ranch
261 Community Development District.

262 B. Exhibit 10: Consideration of Easement Request – 18745 Deer Tracks Loop – Installation of Pool
263 The Board discussed the estimated timeline for a typical pool installation, and the location of the
264 easement and its access points.

265 On a MOTION by Ms. Clawson, SECONDED by Mr. Koford, WITH ALL IN FAVOR, the Board approved
266 the use of easement agreement for the address at 18745 Deer Tracks Loop, for the Long Lake Ranch
267 Community Development District.

268 Following the motion, the Board directed for the homeowner to be informed about accessing the
269 easement area through the side yard vinyl fence on Weather Vane. Comments were also made
270 regarding a previous situation where someone performing construction on Sun Lake property had
271 stored construction materials on the sidewalks. Ms. Dobson stated that she could communicate
272 these to the homeowner and meet with the contractor.

273 C. Exhibit 11: Presentation of Solid Waste Assessment

274 Ms. Dobson noted that a public hearing regarding annual solid waste disposal assessments was
275 scheduled for September 6.

276 D. Exhibit 12: Consideration of HOA’s Landscape Maintenance Request

277 Comments were made by members of the Board questioning the pictures enclosed. Mr. Pellan noted
278 that Counsel had indicated that the request would involve CDD funds coming from the public being
279 used in an area where the public cannot access and benefit.

280 On a MOTION by Ms. Clawson, SECONDED by Mr. Koford, WITH ALL IN FAVOR, the Board rejected
281 the HOA Landscape Maintenance Request for the Long Lake Ranch Community Development District.

282 Following the motion, the Board requested for Ms. Dobson to personally respond to the email.

283 **SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS – Supervisors Requests**

284 Mr. Twomey commented on expenditures that needed to be priorities, such as fences and locks.

285 Mr. Koford asked whether the CDD could purchase a rolling pickleball net and set of paddles and
286 balls.

287 Ms. Clawson requested for the HOA to clean up their clubhouse supplies, and Ms. Dobson noted
288 that she would additionally send out the Vanguard proposal for deep cleaning bathrooms as soon
289 as it was received.

290 Mr. Ruhlig asked for clarification on what the Board wanted out of lake fencing proposals. Mr.
291 Pellan expressed support for proposals by section. Supervisor comments were heard suggesting for
292 weighing options with metal fencing, and for staff to reach out to Daniels for fencing proposals,
293 which Mr. Ruhlig stated he could do along with other companies.

294 **SEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS – Audience Comments – New Business**

295 There being none, the next item followed.

296 **EIGHTH ORDER OF BUSINESS – Next Meeting Quorum Check: October 6th, 6:00 PM**

297 Mr. Pellan, Mr. Koford, and Mr. Twomey confirmed that they would be in attendance at the next
298 meeting, scheduled for October 6 at 6:00 p.m., which would constitute a quorum. Ms. Clawson
299 stated that she would not be able to attend the meeting. Ms. Dobson stated that she would need to
300 contact Mr. Smith for his anticipated attendance status.

301 **NINTH ORDER OF BUSINESS – Adjournment**

302 Ms. Dobson asked for final questions, comments, or corrections before requesting a motion to
303 adjourn the meeting. There being none, Mr. Koford made a motion to adjourn the meeting.

304 On a MOTION by Mr. Koford, SECONDED by Ms. Clawson, WITH ALL IN FAVOR, the Board
305 adjourned the meeting at 9:56 p.m. for the Long Lake Ranch Community Development District.

306 **Each person who decides to appeal any decision made by the Board with respect to any matter considered*
307 *at the meeting is advised that person may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made,*
308 *including the testimony and evidence upon which such appeal is to be based.*

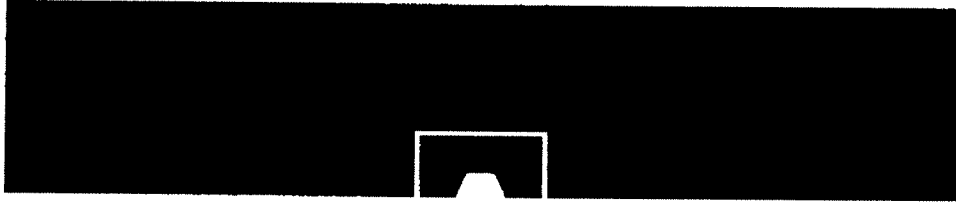

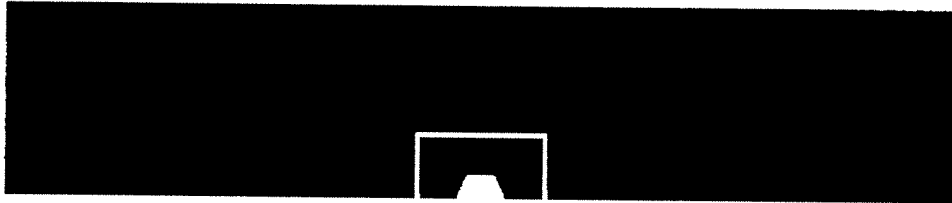

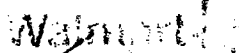
