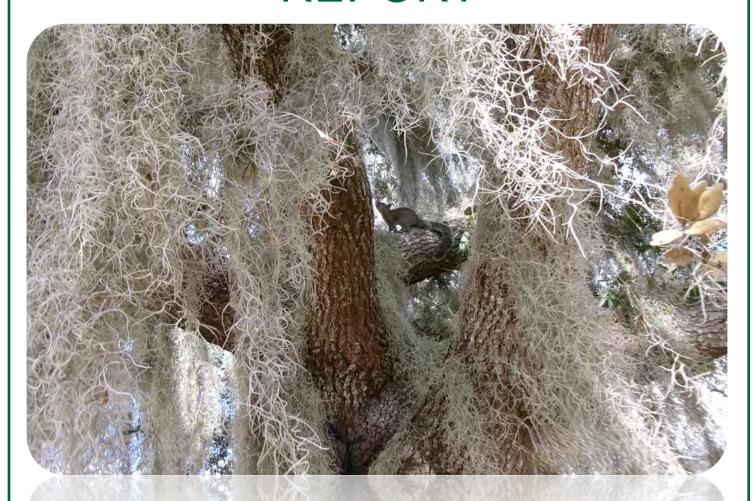

#### **General Updates, Recent & Upcoming Maintenance Events**

- Please provide a scheduled date for trimming the palm fronds and removing spent fruits and flowers.
- ➤ Please begin removing the Spanish moss throughout the property, focusing on areas within reach of the tree limbs.

The following are action items for RedTree Landscaping to complete. Please refer to the item # in your response listing action already taken or anticipated time of completion. Red text indicates deficient from previous report. Bold Red text indicates deficient for more than a month. Green text indicates a proposal has been requested. Blue indicates irrigation. Orange indicates a task to be completed by Staff and BOLD, underlined black indicates a question or update for the BOS.

 Weeds are growing in the cracks of the drains and in patches throughout the mulched areas. Please treat these areas accordingly and hand-pull any weeds over 3 inches in height. (Pic 1)



- One of the driplines along the outside of the pool, just west of the pool area, is cut. Has this issue been addressed and repaired? (Pic 2>)
- 3. Hopefully this is an isolated incident, but during my inspection I found cut plant debris in the Ixora planting beds near the Amenity Center. While this isn't a recurring issue, please remind the crew to always remove plant debris after trimming or cutting.
- 4. The pond across from the Amenity Center has several trees where Spanish moss....

....needs to be removed. Some branches are beginning to grow bare, and a few trees have thinning canopies. Please address this and schedule the necessary maintenance. (Pic 4)







### Pond 40, Pond 60

5. Around Pond 40, please have the aquatics team walk the shoreline and remove all trash and debris. (Pic 5)



 Please begin scheduling crews to remove the Spanish moss from the trees. This specific tree is located on the west side of Pond 40, just across the street from the Amenity Center. (Pic 6)



7. At Pond 60, the crew has again left tire tracks in two areas. The crew needs to follow these steps to prevent and correct this issue: Linetrim the turf in areas where equipment passes to avoid creating tracks. If ruts or indents are created, tamp down the turf to level out the affected areas. Please ensure the crew is reminded and follows these procedures moving forward. (Pic 7a>, 7b>)

8. Around the shoreline of Pond 60, trash is beginning to accumulate. Aquatics team, please remove the debris and provide a proposal for disposal if necessary.(Pic 8a, 8b>)

9. Along the shoreline of Pond 60, a few cypress tree roots were nicked. Please remind the crew to lift the mower blades to prevent this from happening again, as repeated damage can stress the trees. Adjust procedures accordingly. (Pic 9)



- 10. Pond 60 is developing algae blooms along the shoreline. Aquatics team, please treat the affected ponds accordingly and report back your findings. (Pic 10>)
- 11.I am still noticing grape vines hanging over and weighing down several tree limbs, particularly along White Bluff Rd. When should we expect these vines to be removed? Should we consider scheduling High Trim to assist with pushing back the preserve edge so the common area can be properly maintained?

12. Flood Comp 100 — there are small amounts of algae blooms and scattered trash along the edge line. Solitude, please visit the pond to treat and remove debris as needed. (Pic 12a, 12b>)









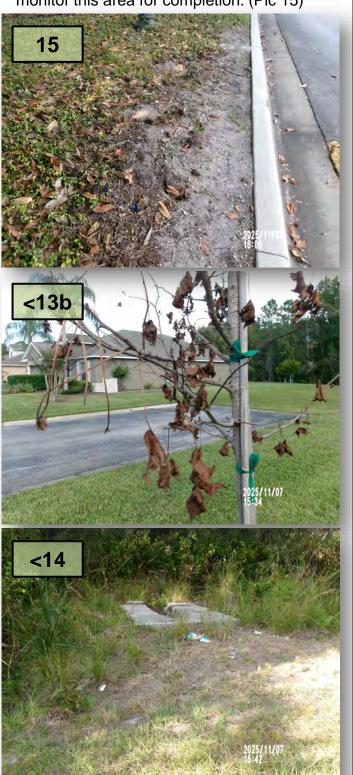

13. The newly planted tree along Flood Comp
120 was reported to RedTree and confirmed
as replaced. However, I noticed the gator bag
included in the proposal was not installed.
RedTree, please confirm whether this item
has been added, as it is especially important
given the ongoing drought conditions.
Additionally, verify if an irrigation dripline is
present in this area. If there is no irrigation in
place, the gator bag line item should be
credited back to the CDD. (Pic 13a, 13b>)



14. On the west side of Flood Comp 120, the drainage structure and the ponds edge has a noticeable buildup of trash, likely carried in by past rainstorms. Please have the mowing crew remove the debris during their next scheduled visit. (Pic 14>) 15. I observed that the newly installed Jasmine plantings, which were included in the mulch proposal, have not yet been mulched. I have reached out to the vendor for confirmation on the installation timeline and will continue to monitor this area for completion. (Pic 15)

16. RedTree, I noticed this object in the ground on the east side of the entrance before entering the gate. Are you familiar with it or aware of its purpose? If it is not something that needs to remain, please provide a proposal for its removal. (Pic 16)





17. This irrigation line was flagged during my inspection — can you please confirm whether it has since been repaired? (Pic 17)

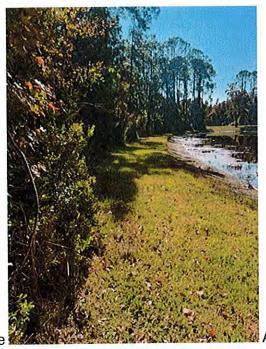

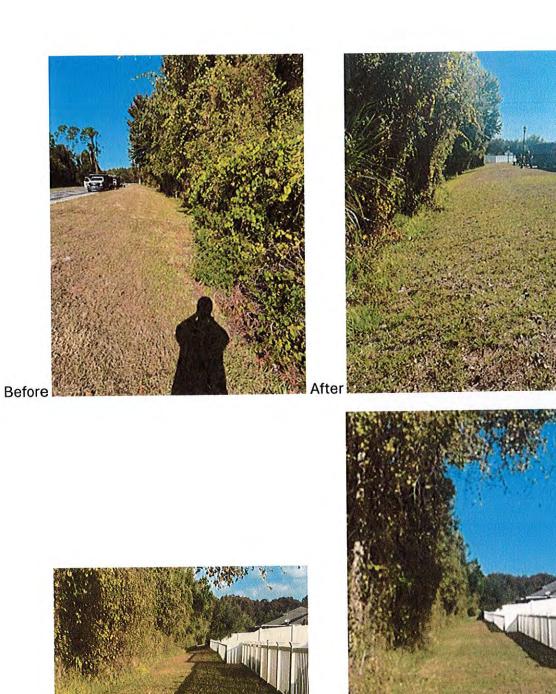

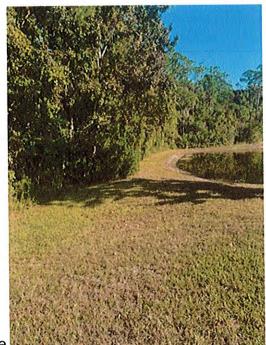

#### **RESOLUTION 2026-01**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE VERANDAHS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT CALLING FOR A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD BY THE PASCO COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN NOVEMBER 2026.

**WHEREAS,** The Verandahs Community Development District (the "**District**") is a local unit of special-purpose government established by Pasco County, Florida (the "**County**");

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Section 190.006(1), Florida Statutes the District Board of Supervisors consists of five members; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 190.006(3), Florida Statutes provides for the election of members to specific terms and seat numbers for the District Board of Supervisors and currently calls for the election of **two (2)** members of the Board of Supervisors of the District for seat numbers and length of terms thereof:

Seat No. 1, Currently held by Tracy Mayle

Seat No. 4, Currently held by Stanely Haupt

Length of term: Four-years

Length of term: Four-years

# NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE VERANDAHS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, THAT:

**Section 1.** General Election. There is hereby called an election in the County to be held concurrent with the General Election on the first Tuesday of November, which is November 3, 2026, for the purpose of having all of the qualified electors residing within the boundaries of the District to determine **two (2) qualified electors** to serve on the Board of Supervisors of the District.

**Section 2. Qualifying Period.** The period of qualifying as a candidate for a supervisor to the district shall be from noon June 8, 2026, through noon June 12, 2026, pursuant to Section 99.061, Florida Statutes. This Resolution shall serve as the District's notice of the qualifying period, pursuant to Section 190.006(3), Florida Statutes. Interested candidates should contact the Supervisor of Elections for the County for further information.

#### Section 3. Conduction and Procedure of Election.

- **a.** The election shall be conducted according to the requirements of general law and law governing special district elections.
- **b.** The election shall be held at the precinct polling places designated by the Supervisor of Elections in the County.
- **c.** The polls shall be opened and closed as provided by law, including, but not limited to Section 100.011. Florida Statutes.
- **d.** The ballot shall contain the names of the candidates to be voted upon, pursuant to Section 101.151. Florida Statutes.
- **e.** The Department of State shall make out a notice stating what offices are to be filled at the general election, pursuant to Section 100.021 Florida Statutes.

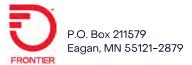

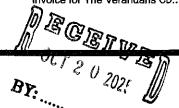

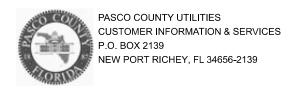
