Mr. Hernandez called the meeting to order and read the roll.

Consideration of the Minutes of the Board of Supervisors' Meeting held on February 24, 2022

Mr. Hernandez presented the meeting minutes held on February 24, 2022, to the Board.

On Motion by Ms. Schuster, seconded by Ms. Kane, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors' approved the minutes of the Board of Supervisors' Meeting held on February 24, 2022, as presented for the Westridge Community Development District.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Review of March 2022 Unaudited Financial Statements

Mr. Hernandez presented the March 2022 unaudited financial statements to the Board.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Ratification of the Operation & Maintenance Expenditures for February 2022 – March 2022

Mr. Hernandez presented the Operation & Maintenance Expenditures to the Board.

On Motion by Ms. Kane, seconded by Ms. Schiffer, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors' ratified the Operation & Maintenance Expenditures for February 2022 (\$6,170.39) and March 2022 (\$45,220.84), for the Westridge Community Development District.

SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Resolution 2022-04, Shortening Terms of Office

Mr. Hernandez presented Resolution 2022-04 to the Board. Mr. Clark briefly advised that due to the District being established in 2003, an odd-number year, Florida Statues requires the Board of Supervisors, whose terms currently end in an odd-numbered year, to be adjusted (shortened) to comply with the law regarding general elections.

Resolution 2022-04 adjusts the Board of Supervisors seat terms that expire in November 2025, currently occupied by Susan Kane (Seat #1) and Nora Schuster (Seat #2), will be shortened to expire in November 2024. In addition, the Board of Supervisors seats that expire in November 2023, currently occupied by Martha Schiffer (Seat #3), Maria Perez (Seat #4), and Louis Cioffi (Seat #5), will be shortened to expire in November 2022.

On Motion by Ms. Schuster, seconded by Ms. Schiffer, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors' adopted Resolution 2022-04 Shortening Terms of Office, for the Westridge Community Development District.

Consideration of Resolution 2022-05, Resolution as to Election Qualification Period

Mr. Hernandez presented Resolution 2022-05 to the Board. Mr. Clark advised that each time the District participates in General Elections by Florida Statue, section 190.006(3), the District is required to publish the notice of the qualifying period. **Exhibit A** is intended to be published at least two weeks before the start of the qualification period in a local publication.

Resolution 2022-05 specifies Seat 3, currently held by Martha Schiffer, Seat 4, currently held by Maria Perez, and Seat currently held by Louis Cioffi, are scheduled for the General Election in November 2022.

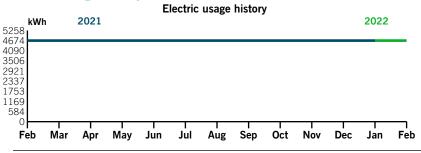

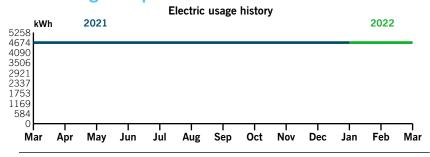

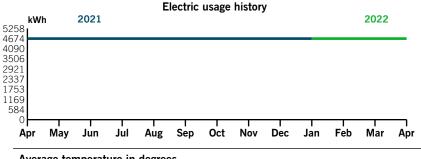
