Course Description: This course is the second in a sequence designed as a survey of biological concepts for non-science majors. Topics include evolution, ecology, plant anatomy and physiology, and animal anatomy and physiology.

Prerequisites: BIOL 101 with a C or better

On completion of this course, the student will be able to:

1. Understand evolution and diversity of animals.
2. Define ecology and population and describe factors that affect population.
3. Describe communities, ecosystems, biomes, and biodiversity and factors that affect them.
4. Describe the parts, function, and reproduction of both nonflowering and flowering plants.
5. Define tissue, organ, and organ system for animals and describe the different types.
6. Describe the parts and function of an animal nervous system, how it influences the internal environment, and it interprets the external environment.
7. Describe the parts and function of an animal endocrine system and the role it plays in regulation.
8. Describe the parts and function of an animal's skeletal and muscular systems, circulatory and respiratory systems, and digestive and urinary systems.

9. Describe the parts and function of the immune system and differentiate between the types of immunity.
10. Describe animal reproduction and development.
