Frequently Asked Questions Regarding COVID-19 and Financial Aid

If I resign from College will I owe money?

Maybe. You must complete 60% of class time in order to earn the total amount of aid awarded to you. Please contact the Office of Financial Aid to speak with a financial aid professional to understand all of your options before resigning from the college. If I am currently enrolled, will I still receive my Financial Aid due to the COVID-19 pandemic?

Yes, as long as you are still enrolled and **ATTENDING** classes through modified instructional delivery or online operations. For loan students, you must be attending at least six (6) financial aid credit hours to receive loans.

How do I apply for financial aid for Summer 2020 or Fall 2020?

To apply for federal financial aid (Pell Grant, SEOG, Federal Direct Loans, Federal Work-Study) you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov or download the myStudentAid mobile app in the Apple App Store (iOS) or the Google Play store (Android). Be sure to add Delta's school code to your FAFSA – **04130100**.

How can I check the status of my financial aid?

You can check the status of your Financial Aid in your LoLA account or contact the Office of Financial Aid at 318-345-9005. You will need to know your Student ID number to speak with the Office of Financial Aid over the phone.
