Purpose

Information about laws governing disability services at Louisiana Delta Community College and student's responsibilities in apply for these services.

Scope

All Louisiana Delta Community College students and prospective students.

Policy

Louisiana Delta Community College complies with federal laws to ensure students with disabilities equity and access to college programs. The federal laws applicable to post-secondary students with disabilities are:

- The ADA Amendments Act of 2008 (ADAAA)
- The Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA)
- The Rehabilitation Act of 1973/Section 504

These federal laws ensure equal opportunity for qualified students with disabilities. Louisiana Delta Community College makes reasonable accommodations to provide access for all campus activities and programs.

A student with a disability must self-identify in order to request academic accommodations or auxiliary aids. Additionally, students with disabilities requesting disability services are required to provide documentation of the disability. The student is responsible for both furnishing the disability documentation and the cost of obtaining the disability documentation.
