

## **NOTICE TO TOWN CENTER AT PALM COAST COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT RESIDENTS**

The Board of Supervisors (“the Board”) of the Town Center at Palm Coast Community Development District (“the District”) currently has two vacancies: Seat 2 with the term expiring November 2024, and Seat 3 with the term expiring November 2022. The Board is seeking a Qualified Elector candidate to fill these seats.

Per Florida Statute, 190.0033(17), a Qualified Elector means any person at least 18 years of age, who is a citizen of the United States, a legal resident of Florida and of the District, and who is registered to vote with the Supervisor of Elections in Flagler County, where the District land is located.

Please note that all materials provided become part of the public record.

Interested candidates will be required to attend the next meeting on **January 15, 2021 at 10:00 a.m.** so they may address the Board regarding their candidacy, and if appointed, be able to immediately assume the office at that meeting.
