

POLICIES OF THE FOREST CREEK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

DISTRICT INTERNET ACCESS POLICY

1. Purpose

1.1. The District offers internet access through the wireless (Wi-Fi) service in the recreation center (Clubhouse, Pool, SPA, Grill and Fitness Center). The purpose of this policy is to establish the policy regarding District-provided internet access. Failure to abide by this policy may result in suspension of access to or use of District Facilities and/or District Property or services.

2. Responsibilities

2.1. User Responsibilities

2.1.1. The District assumes no responsibility for any damages, direct or indirect, that may occur from the use of its electronic resources and District internet access. Further, the District assumes no responsibility for accuracy, authority, objectivity, currency, or content of any internet resource. Any persons using District internet access do so at their own risk, and, in using District internet access, shall indemnify, defend, and hold the District harmless from any and all damages, liabilities, claims, or causes of action of any kind or nature arising from or related to such use.

2.1.2. Use of the District's internet access for purposes contrary to local, state or federal law, or in a manner that violates this rule, is expressly prohibited and may result in the suspension or termination of access to or use of District facilities and/or District Property or services. Such violations may include, but are not limited to:

- Computer related crimes as defined in Florida Statute, Title XLVI, Chapter 815.
- Intentionally displaying, sending, or receiving inappropriate materials in either text or graphic format that may be reasonably construed as obscene, child pornography, or harmful to minors.
- Propagating malicious software.
- Unauthorized copying of copyrighted material.
- Unauthorized access to files or systems.

2.1.3. Computer Use by Minors

2.1.3.1. Parents and/or legal guardians are solely responsible for internet access and use by their children on District property
