

MS. BOSSIER PARISH COMMUNITY COLLEGE PAGEANT

A tradition since 1990, a pageant is held annually in the spring to select a student to represent Bossier Parish Community College as a hostess, spokesperson, and ambassador both on campus and in the community. Contestants are judged on leadership in academic and extracurricular activities, citizenship, service to the college and the community, poise, personality, professionalism, ability to express opinions and thoughts in a clear and articulate manner, as well as personal presentation and attractiveness. The titleholder is expected to be a person of high moral character and a student with a great deal of school pride and spirit. This role requires some public speaking, and any student interested in applying should feel comfortable in the public eye. Contestants may enter the pageant twice. Various prizes are awarded including a full-tuition waiver plus books for the titleholder.

ENTRY DEADLINE MEETING

The entry deadline meeting will be held Thursday, March 5, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. in F-220.

This is a mandatory meeting for all pageant contestants! Failure to attend could result in disqualification. Contestant headshots will be taken for the judges' books; and, contestant numbers will be drawn at this meeting.

QUALIFICATIONS

All Ms. BPCC Pageant contestants must meet the following qualifications:

- Plan to attend BPCC next fall semester
- Have and maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA or higher
- Be nominated by a student organization, academic department, or faculty/staff member
- Have completed 2 regular academic semesters (fall/spring) or have at least 12 credit hours at BPCC
- Be a full-time student enrolled in 12 hours or more and maintain full-time status through next fall semester

Failure to maintain GPA and enrollment requirements will result in immediate disqualification.
