They are also making every effort to treat others with respect, including their teachers, staff, and other students throughout the school.

Every child will be encouraged to earn the title of **"Kid On The Go"** each quarter of the school year by <u>GETTING</u> the job done, making <u>GREAT</u> efforts each and every day, and by <u>GOING</u> through each school day demonstrating responsible and respectful actions.

At the end of each quarter, students will have the opportunity to celebrate their earned success as a **"Kid On The Go"** by attending a special, fun-filled field trip. *Every student must understand that these field trips are* <u>earned</u> and require consistently positive behavior and work completion throughout the quarter.

The following criteria indicate the meaning of a child earning the title of "Kid On The Go":

- 1. It is expected that a child have no more than six [6] separate days with missing homework and/or a demonstration of poor work attitude in the classroom.
- 2. It is expected that a student displays no more than three [3] minor misbehavior conducts or disrespectful behaviors directed at another student or staff member. A serious infraction such as hitting or bullying may result in immediate ineligibility for the quarterly celebration.
