

# NESD LIVESTREAMING AGREEMENT

2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

Livestreaming classroom instruction, in which a camera is used to broadcast live video content through the internet, is an option available to North East students during the 2020-2021 school year. **Student participation in this method of instructional delivery is a privilege. Failure to adhere to this agreement may result in the student's reassignment to another form of instructional delivery, as well as disciplinary action up to and including expulsion ([NESD Policy Code 218](#)). The decision to permit a student to participate or not participate remotely via livestream video rests in the sole discretion of the district.**

## RECORDING LIVESTREAM

The recording of livestream video is strictly prohibited. Recording livestream video is grounds for immediate reassignment of the student's instructional delivery method, as well as appropriate disciplinary action.

## ATTENDANCE

In order to be marked present, students must be logged in at hours during which they receive instruction. Students must have their computer camera turned on. It is understood that there may be times when the teacher permits the student to work independently at home, at which point the student may turn off his or her camera with teacher permission. The teacher must take and report attendance during each period and bring any issues to the attention of the building administrator.

## PROPER ATTIRE/ CODE OF CONDUCT

Any student participating in a livestream for academic instruction must abide by the district's Code of Conduct and may be held accountable for violations of the Code of Conduct while participating in the livestream. Students participating in a livestream of academic instruction must also be dressed in proper attire consistent with the district's dress code (Code 221).
