Good Afternoon North East Family,

Please be advised that on Thursday, December 3, 2020, the District Office was notified of one positive and one probable case of COVID19, both at the high school. The last day the students were on campus was on November 19, 2020 and November 28, 2020. The district has already contacted close contacts of the students.

We would like to thank our staff and families who have done an outstanding job of following the district guidelines and for communicating with our schools. This is a reminder that there is a revised State Order for face masks and a new State Order for travel. These Orders are in effect and can be found under the update tab on the district website @nesd1.org. In addition, the district will be updating the Health and Safety plan to include the new mitigation requirements from the Department of Health and Department of Education. These changes will be posted by the end of the day Friday.

Please keep in mind that in the event a family member is being tested, or a student is contacted by the Department of Health to quarantine, your child will be able to livestream during this time. The health and safety of our students and staff is our number one priority. We ask if you believe you have been in contact with anyone who may have symptoms of COVID-19 or you experience one or more symptoms from Group A or two or more symptoms from Group B below, to please stay home and contact your health care provider.
