



# VACCINATION CLINIC

LECOM in partnership with the Erie County Department of Health is conducting a local COVID-19 vaccination clinic (Pfizer) hosted on the North East School District campus as follows:

**Location: North East Middle School**

**First Pfizer Dose: Thursday, July 22<sup>nd</sup> - 3:00-7:00 p.m.**

**Second Pfizer Dose: Thursday, August 12<sup>th</sup> - 3:00-7:00 p.m.**

The clinic is open to any community member or minor child twelve (12) years old and older. Parents must be present for ages 18 and under.
