Dear North East Family,

As a reminder, our number one goal is to keep our students and staff safe and to keep our buildings open. After holiday break, the North East School District will continue to follow our district Health and Safety Plan for indoor masking which includes masking while Erie County COVID-19 transmission rates are in substantial or high. Masking will be required in all North East schools by all students, employees, and visitors in the New Year. Additionally, the Federal masking requirement for public transportation is still in effect. Students are required to wear masks on school buses and any school vehicle for all transportation activities and events.

The Erie County Department of Health has released new quarantine guidelines. We will be transitioning to MOST of these new quarantine guidelines; however, please note, since strict masking is required for exposures from day six through day ten from last exposure, participation in extra-curricular and athletics will continue to be ten days, returning on day eleven to the activity. We will also begin a pilot Test to Stay program provided by the State for students and staff. Please be patient as we navigate this new resource in the North East School District. Please go to the website link below to sign an electronic consent form for your child. You MUST fill out one for each building that your child attends- you must use the unique code associated with the school building for registration (it took me less than a minute to register my child). This will provide our nurses with the option of providing a rapid test for your child to stay in school if they have "flu-like" symptoms. In addition to the on-line consent, our nurses will contact parents for a verbal consent prior to conducting ANY rapid testing. We must have both the on-line consent and the verbal permission (verbal when called) for participation in this program. Please note that the North East School District IS NOT and WILL NOT be participating in the pooled portion of the test to stay program, ONLY the rapid antigen testing portion listed on the on-line consent form. Guidance on Quarantine and Isolation

Updated as of Dec. 27, 2021

For additional guidance or questions, call 814-451-6700

For quarantine and isolation: Stay home. Do not go to school, work or attend social activities. Do not allow visitors in your home. Additional for isolation: Stay in a specific "sick room" or area and use a separate bathroom if available. See below for guidance on number of days you are required to quarantine and isolate.

Quarantine is for when you might have been exposed to the virus and may or may not have been infected.

Isolation is for when you have been infected with the virus, even if you don't have symptoms.
