PROSPECTIVE TEACHER SUBSTITUTES

Per Act 86 of 2016, the North East School District may allow a prospective teacher to serve as a classroom substitute if the individual:

- Is currently enrolled in a Pennsylvania-approved college or university educator preparation program;
- Has completed at least 60 semester hours or equivalent; and
- Meets all statutory requirements related to clearances, citizenship, and good moral character.

Students meeting the above requirements may teach a maximum of 10 days in a single classroom and a maximum of 20 days per school year.

Teacher prep program students interested in Substituting in the classrooms should submit the following:

- Standard PA Teaching Application
- Proof of Current Enrollment Status
- Unofficial Transcript showing completion of at least 60 Semester hours or equivalent
- All required Pennsylvania clearances
- Physical Exam and Negative PPD
- Act 126 Mandated Reporter training certificate
