



Stone County School District 2021-2022 School Year

Students Return: Thursday, August 5th

The Stone County School District will return to a **Traditional** classroom setting for the 2021-2022 school year. This setting requires students to be physically present at school. Stone County School District will consider guidance from the CDC and follow mandates from the state and federal government.

Transportation

- Hand sanitizer will be available on every bus.
- Drivers will sanitize the bus at the conclusion of all bus routes.
- Students and bus drivers may wear masks that follow dress code while on the bus.

Food / Nutrition

- All cafeterias will be open and fully functional.
- Covered or individually wrapped food items will be offered when feasible.
- Sneeze guards have been installed and hand sanitization stations will be available.

Health and Safety

- Masks that meet dress code will be optional for both students and adults.
- Temperature checks will not be required.
- Quarantine/contact tracing procedures will be continued.
- Hand sanitizer will be placed at all school entrances and in all classrooms.
- Daily sanitization procedures will continue.
- Per the Stone County School District, all visitors must check-in through the front office.
