<p>Return requirements do not apply to non-illness related healthcare appointments (dental, optical, mental health, etc.), however, a note or appointment card from the provider will be required.</p>			

If quarantined student is healthy enough to participate remotely, please contact your teacher by requested time per building plan (9:00 or 9:30 a.m.) to be counted present. If quarantined student is not healthy enough to participate remotely, please notify building office of the absence by the requested time.

“Close Contact” is defined as being within 6 ft. of an individual for more than 15 minutes within the last 48 hours

COVID-19 symptoms include fever, fatigue headache, muscle/body aches, cough, nasal congestion, loss of taste or smell, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, abdominal pain/nausea, diarrhea/vomiting
