Elementary School Supply Lists

Below you will find the lists of necessary school supplies for each grade for Cochranton Elementary School. Please send supplies in a large zip-lock bag(s) marked with the student's name.

Kindergarten

- Container of wipes
- 1 book bag (without wheels)
- 2 medium plastic flip lid crayon/pencil box (usually costs \$1.00)
- Crayola Crayons - 2 packs of 24 colors
- 1 highlighter (any color)
- 2 bottles of Elmer's Liquid Glue
- 4 large/thick/big glue sticks (at least .77 oz)
- 1 box of colored pencils (12 - 24 pack)
- 1 - 8 pack of thin washable markers
- 1 Pack of Broadline (fat) washable markers 1 large rectangular eraser
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 12 count package #2 Ticonderoga pencils
- 2 Pocket folders - plastic coated preferred
- 1 blunt tip scissors
- 6 Dry Erase markers - black color preferred
- Water Bottle - must have spill proof lid
- Personal, small hand sanitizer
- Headphones (not earbuds)
- 2 large rectangular erasers
- Mask

First Grade

- 1 pair blunt tip scissors
- 2 - #2 Ticonderoga Pencils (non-mechanical, no plastic coating)
- 2 packs of pencil top erasers

Second Grade

- 1 box of tissues

 - Sandwich Ziploc baggies
 - Gallon Ziploc baggies
 - Lysol wipes (or thieves' cleaner)
 - Paper towels
 - Ultra-fine tip expo markers (at least 2)

- 4 Spiral notebooks (one red, one blue, one yellow, one green)
- 1 composition book for writing
- 2 - 1 ½ inch binders for science and reading
- 2 plastic pocket folders for a take home folder
- Student scissors
- Disinfectant wipes
- 2 pairs of Earbuds (one for school, one that travels home)
- Wireless mouse if preferred
