Purpose

The Board recognizes that students are part of the informed public, and in accordance with students' rights and responsibilities, they should have a voice in the affairs of the district.

Students shall have input, through designated representatives, at a specified time during the regular monthly Board meeting.

Student Representatives

The Board shall request student representation from Meadville Area Senior High School and Cochran Junior-Senior High School. Each school shall have two (2) representatives.

Each student shall serve a one-year term and represent his/her school in an appropriate manner. Each representative must maintain the grade eligibility requirements of his/her respective school.

A student may be removed from the position as representative to the Board if s/he is subject to disciplinary action. A suspension of any kind shall result in the immediate removal of that student as representative to the Board.[1][2]

Responsibility

The Superintendent or his/her designee shall be responsible for the enforcement of this policy, and for establishing and implementing procedures for selection of student representatives to the Board.
