Student athletes who are interested in a particular sport should start preparing for sport registration well in advance. It is the athlete/parent responsibility to be aware of sign-in dates and obtain the sport information needed to participate. Please feel free to contact our office with any questions or to pick up information.

Fall Sport Registration – All Fall Sports will open beginning July 23rd thru August 6th. The first practice for Boys Golf and Football will be August 3rd and all other sports will start on August 10th. You must be Rostered to attend first practice, please contact Ms Merlino in the CCHS Athletic office to verify. (*see below)

Winter Sport Registration – Registration will be October 30th thru November 7th, with practices beginning November 16th.

Spring Sport Registration – Registration will be February 10th thru the 13th and February 18th thru the 21st. Boys Volleyball will start on February 22nd all other practices will start on March 1st.

* **ROSTERED.** You will be rostered for coach once you have all requirements met. When the online registration is completed <https://account.students.arbitersports.com/signup> Contact Ms Merlino to pay your fee or have it added to the parent portal via Infinite Campus, you may also bring it into the canon city high school athletic office. Once everything is verified and the fee has been paid you will receive your confirmation of being rostered/cleared on coaches spreadsheet to participate. You must communicate this with your coach that you have been **Rostered.**

The annual maximum expenditure for extracurricular fees per family for Canon City High School students is established at \$460, \$345, or \$230, depending on eligibility.

To qualify for athletics and activities fee discounts, students must be enrolled in the free or reduced-price lunch program.

Applications for the free or reduced-price lunch program may be obtained at the Canon City Schools Administration Office starting July 01 .

Effective August 01 These applications will also be available through the Canon City High School Athletics and Activities Office.

Pursuant to CRS 22-32-116.5, specific regulations apply to **home-schooled students and individuals not enrolled at Canon City High School**. A mandatory \$225 cash deposit for uniforms and equipment is required for all participating student-athletes who do not attend CCHS. This deposit is refundable upon the student's departure from the program in good standing, provided all issued property is returned. Furthermore, in accordance with Colorado state law, all students participating in school activities must provide proof of vaccination or a valid exemption.
