



Lunch and Cafeteria Information

The school lunch program at STMS is run by a company named, Nutriserve. Nutriserve's goal is to serve nutritious, well-balanced meals that are appealing to students. They offer a wide variety of options for lunch each day including pizza, salads, hot meals and cold sandwiches. A variety of fresh fruits, vegetables, snacks and beverages are also available.

There is an emphasis on healthy eating and many of the offerings are whole grain items and items with reduced total fat, sodium and saturated fat.

How do children pay for lunch?

Each student has an ID number which can be used to purchase lunch in the cafeteria. At the cash register, students enter their ID number into a keypad and the amount is automatically deducted from their account. A running list of all purchases is recorded electronically at the same time. Parents may add money to a student's account either by sending in a check, cash, or by adding money online with Visa, MasterCard, Discover, Debit, or Electronic check.
