# Room 1

### 6 WEEKS TO 12 MONTHS

#### Bedding

- (5) Fitted crib sheets (1 Daily)
- (5) Receiving blankets (1 Daily)
- (1) Heavy blanket

#### Clothing

Please dress your child appropriately for play.

Extra Clothing (3 complete sets)

- (1) Pair of indoor shoes
- (1) Pair of outdoor shoes

#### Meals

Bottles - Enough bottles filled with formula/breast milk for the day, labeled and dated daily (Bottles must be pre-made and will be warmed).

Required - sippy cup, spoon and bowl.

#### Food

Breakfast, lunch and snack foods that have been introduced at home as needed (**label and date all containers**).

#### Bibs

Cloth bibs while drinking bottles, plastic oversized bibs for when child starts eating table food or drinks from a cup.

#### Burp Cloth

(4) Washcloths.

#### Pacifiers

If pacifiers are used, please provide several clean pacifiers and a labeled ziploc baggie to place the used ones in.

#### Diapers, wipes, sunscreen, ointments

Diapers must be labeled with the child's name on the front of the diaper. Please label wipes container and any ointments.

Preferred sunscreen (waiver needed on file)

### 12 MONTHS TO 24 MONTHS

#### Bedding

- (5) Fitted crib sheets (1 Daily)
- (5) Blankets (1 Daily)

#### Clothing

- (2) Extra sets of clothing
- (1) Pair of indoor shoes
- (1) Pair of outdoor shoes

#### Pacifiers

May be used as they transition up to 30 days. No children will be allowed to walk around with a pacifier in their mouth.

#### Diapers, wipes, sunscreen, ointments

Diapers must be labeled with the child's name on the front of the diaper. Please label wipes container and any ointments.

Preferred sunscreen (waiver needed on file)

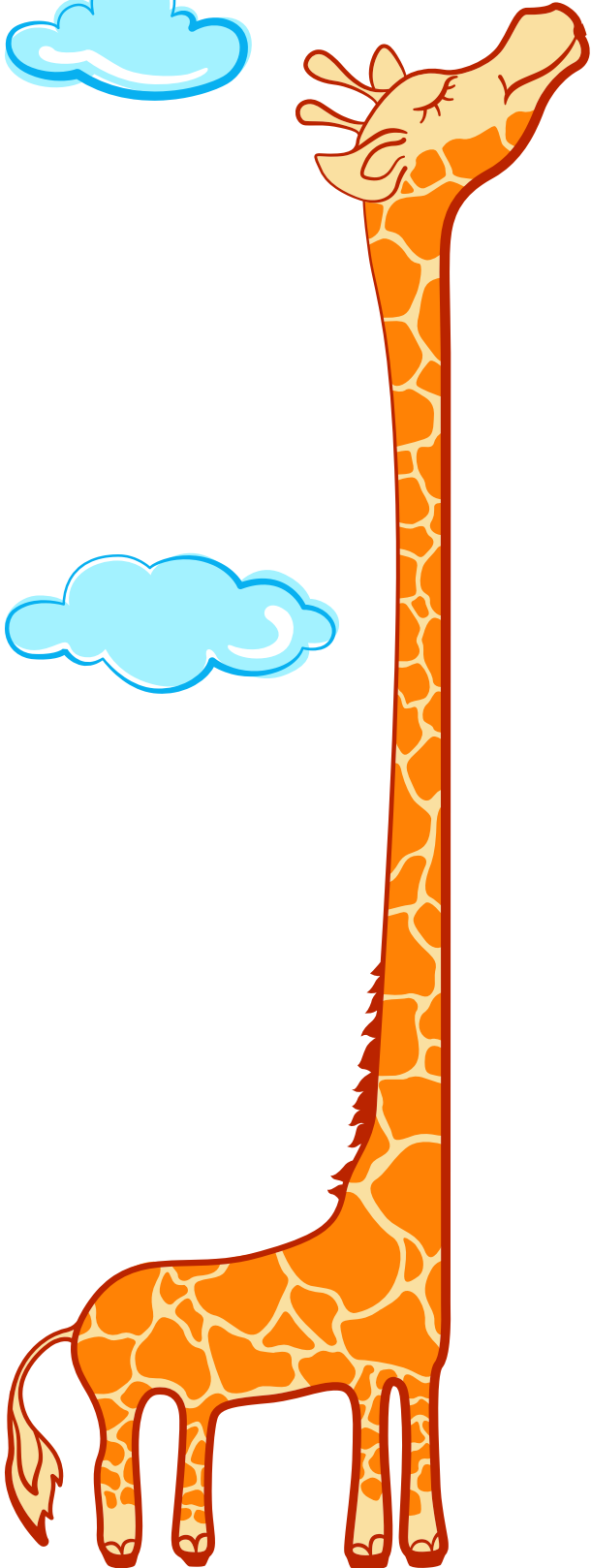
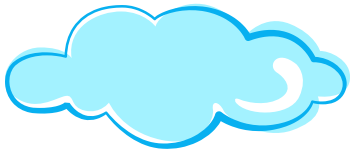

### FOR ALL CHILDREN

- 5 crib sheets (1 daily)
- 5 crib sized blankets (1 daily)
- Baby wipes (please replenish as needed)
- Soft, insulated lunch container (with 2 ice packs and utensils)
- Disposable bags for soiled clothes/diapers (1 pack)
- Extra pair of close-toed shoes with socks (required daily)
- 1 pair of indoor shoes
- Alba Botanica Sunscreen (waiver needed on file)

### FOR CHILDREN IN DIAPERS

- Diapers
- 4 complete sets of extra clothes (weather appropriate)

### FOR CHILDREN BEING TOILET TRAINED

- 6 pairs of underwear
- 4 complete sets of extra clothes (weather appropriate)
- 4 pairs of socks

### FOR CHILDREN WHO ARE FULLY TOILET TRAINED

- 2 pairs of underwear
- 2 complete sets of extra clothes (weather appropriate)
- 4 pairs of socks

### SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR ROOM 3 CHILDREN

- 1 box of jumbo crayons (8 count)
- Solid-colored pencil box
- 6.5 quart plastic container (to be kept in the locker)

**NOTE:** No open-toed shoes; socks must be worn each day during drop off for the children's safety
