The patient's stay will include pre-screening, assessment, admission, medical stabilization and appropriate discharge planning. While in our care, the patient will receive treatment based on established protocols that also includes screening for contagious diseases as well as tuberculosis.

Our program is designed for those adult patients, 16 years and older requiring withdrawal management for: alcohol, benzodiazepines, opioids, heroin, cocaine, methamphetamines, amphetamines, marijuana and prescription pain killers.
