### Are you fully vaccinated?

#### Here is the updated guidance:

Last week, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) [updated its guidance](#) for people fully vaccinated against COVID-19 to ensure they would not unknowingly transmit virus to others. This update was in response to [recent data](#) on the ability of vaccinated people to transmit the Delta variant.

#### New CDC guidance includes:

- Vaccinated people should wear masks indoors if they are in an area of high or substantial transmission
  - Learn if you are in an area of high or substantial transmission at the CDC's [COVID Data Tracker](#).
- Everyone in a K-12 school setting, vaccinated or unvaccinated, should be masked.
- Fully vaccinated people who have a known exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 should be tested 3-5 days after exposure, even if they don't have symptoms, and wear a mask in public indoor settings for 14 days or until they receive a negative test result.

### Free Colts tickets!

As part of the Indianapolis Colts training camp at [Grand Park Sport Campus](#) in Westfield, a [COVID-19 vaccine clinic](#) will be on-site administering the two-dose Pfizer vaccine\*, approved for people 12 and older. **Two preseason game tickets to the Panthers vs. Colts game on Sunday, Aug. 15, will be given to each person who receives a vaccine before game day.** (\*The second vaccine dose will be scheduled when you receive your first dose. No appointment necessary.)



- Report any adverse effects from any vaccine to the [Vaccine Adverse Effect Reporting System \(VAERS\)](#).






### Total Individuals Fully Vaccinated\*
