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Lafayette Parish LEAP Results Continue to Rise

Yesterday, the Louisiana Department of Education released spring 2016 LEAP results for grades 3-8. Overall, Lafayette Parish students showed steady improvement in ELA, math, and science. 43% of Lafayette Parish students scored at the Advanced or Mastery level which puts the district in the 82nd percentile rank among Louisiana districts and five points higher than state average. Since 2012 the district has risen from a rank of 14th to 11th in the state. The rise in test scores is a measure of the success of the district's academic initiatives which are designed to focus teachers on best practices and help students rise to higher levels of rigor in the classroom.

All grade levels and subjects increased the percentage of students scoring Advanced or Mastery on the test, with the exception of 7th grade ELA and 6th grade science. Some of the high performance highlights include the following.

- L.J. Alleman Middle--64% of 7th graders scored Advanced or Mastery in ELA and math while 69% of 8th graders in ELA and 66% in math
- Paul Breaux Middle--62% of 7th graders scored Advanced or Mastery in ELA and 62% of 8th graders in ELA
- Edgar Martin Middle--60% of 8th graders scored Advanced or Mastery in math
- Youngsville Middle--61% of 8th graders scored Advanced or Mastery in ELA
- Milton Elementary/Middle--63% of 3rd graders scored Advanced or Mastery in ELA and 71% in math, while 60% of 4th graders in ELA and 63% in math and 60% of 7th graders scored Advanced or Mastery in ELA and 60% of 8th graders in math
- Broadmoor Elementary--61% of 3rd graders scored Advanced or Mastery in ELA and 69% of 4th graders in math
- Ernest Gallet Elementary--60% of 5th graders scored Advanced or Mastery in ELA
- L. Leo Judice Elementary--65% of 3rd graders scored Advanced or Mastery in math and 68% of 4th graders in math while 78% of 5th graders in ELA, 63% in math and 60% in science
- G. T. Lindon Elementary--60% of 3rd graders scored Advanced or Mastery in ELA and 75% in math, 71% of 4th graders in math
- Myrtle Place Elementary--62% of the 3rd graders scored Advanced or Mastery in math
- Plantation Elementary--61% of 3rd graders scored Advanced or Mastery in math while 65% of 5th graders scored Advanced or Mastery in math
- Prairie Elementary, 61% of 3rd graders scored Advanced or Mastery in math
- Westside Elementary--63% of 3rd graders scored Advanced or Mastery in math
- Woodvale Elementary--73% of the 3rd graders scored Advanced or Mastery in math, 74% of 4th graders in ELA and 69% in math

The state considers students proficient who score Basic, Mastery or Advanced on the LEAP test. With regard to proficiency, math performance improved across the district. Grades 3, 5, 6, and 8 saw an increase in ELA. Science performance improved for grades 3, 4, 5, and 8. Compared to the state, Lafayette Parish saw greater overall gains from 2015 to 2016. Lafayette outperformed the

state in math in all grades. ELA results show higher proficiency rates in grades 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7, and equal to the state in grade 8. Science achievement exceeded the state results in grades 3, 4, 5, 7, and 8.

Additional support and resources have been dedicated to the principals of the district's emerging schools. The academic initiatives put in place have yielded positive results. Carencro Heights Elementary showed modest gains with an overall proficiency rate in all three subjects of 51% compared to 48% in 2015. Showing significant gains were Alice Boucher Elementary with 8% growth and J.W. Faulk Elementary with 13% growth. Making significant growth in ELA was J.W. Faulk with a gain of 9.1% in the proficiency rate when compared to 2015 data. J.W. Faulk also grew 18.4% in science, more than any other Lafayette Parish school. All three emerging schools demonstrated growth in mathematics. Alice Boucher increased its rate of proficiency in math by 15.9%.

In addition, Duson Elementary showed remarkable gains by soaring from 36% to 49% proficient. Compared to the previous year, Duson Elementary grew 15.1% in ELA, 15.1% in math and 17.2% in science.

Superintendent Aguillard remarked that the gains in test scores "reflect a school system, a school board, and a community all united in their commitment to provide academic excellence for Lafayette Parish public school students."
