

Annual Budget Votes and Board Elections

The Liverpool Central School District and the Liverpool Public Library Budget Votes and Board Elections for the fiscal year 2020-2021 will be held remotely **and all voting will be done through absentee ballots.**

An absentee ballot to be returned via a postage pre-paid return envelope **will be mailed to all registered voters** on or about May 26, 2020.

Absentee ballots must be received by the LCSD District Clerk **by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, June 9, 2020.**

Who can vote?

A registered voter is someone who is a citizen of the United States; 18 years of age or older; resident of the school district for at least a 30-day period immediately preceding the election; and registered with the Board of Voter Registration or the Onondaga County Board of Elections.
