

## STUDENT VEHICLES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

The following rules are intended to provide information and guidance for students who drive to and park on school property. The list of rules is not intended to be exhaustive and school administrators are empowered to sanction students for any driving behavior that is considered inappropriate and/or unsafe. All rules of the school district governing student conduct are applicable to the privilege of driving to school.

### Parking and Driving Regulations

- All cars parked on school district property must be registered with the building administration by obtaining a registration tag. The registration tag must be properly displayed.
- Students are to use the designated entrances and exits to the parking areas.
- Students are to use the designated parking areas.
- Drugs alcohol and/or tobacco in any form are forbidden in the student's possession or in the student's vehicle.
- Students must operate the vehicle in a safe manner at all times.
- Travel is limited to 10 miles per hour on school property.
- Students should lock their vehicles during the school day.
- School officials reserve the right to inspect vehicles on school property and students are responsible for the contents of their vehicles.
- Students must obey all North Dakota laws while on school property.
- Driving infractions may be reported to the Dickinson Police Department.
- Possessing weapons on the student' person or in the vehicle is prohibited.
- The school administration is empowered to issue fines for inappropriate parking/driving behavior.
- Vehicles may be towed at the owner's expense.
- Violations of the parking and driving regulations will result in disciplinary action up to and including suspension and/or expulsion from school.
