Please note that in subsequent years, those districts Accredited with Priority Improvement Plan, Priority Improvement Plan (low participation), Turnaround Plan, or Turnaround Plan (low participation) which are applying for district-wide calendars of less than 160 scheduled school days for all schools in the district will continue to submit additional information (respective school calendars, class schedules, assembly schedules, bell schedule including lunch time interval, professional development calendar) to the Department so that CDE can review the use and prioritization of instructional time. Again, details of the information to be submitted in subsequent years will continue to be communicated via the Scoop.
