To date Climb for the Kids, a scholarship fund to help underwrite student participation in Nativity's Exchange Program, has received over \$40,000 and awarded almost \$14,000 in scholarhips. Corryville Catholic library volunteers: Corryville Catholic School is an outreach service of the Catholic Intercity School Education (CISE) program. Corryville is located at 108 Calhoun Street and has 202 students in preschool through 8th grade who are a predominately low income population. We have a dedicated group of library volunteers who read with the children each week. Many of the students are below the standard reading level for their grade and can use one-on-one reading time with a positive role model. Library volunteers come on Tuesday mornings, however due to a scheduling conflict this year, the 7th grade has library in the afternoon when all the library volunteers have gone home. We are in search of positive role models who are willing to volunteer their time to read with a 7th grade student for 45 minutes on Tuesdays at 1:00 pm. If Tuesday mornings work better we can always use library volunteers for the other grade levels. If you are not interested in volunteering in the library, we also need 8th grade mentors on Wednesdays at 11:15 am.
