- Encourage your student to do their best.






#### **Meadow Lane Construction Update**

Wow, it feels like the construction crew is working double time as the building is changing everyday.

Again, the beautiful weather has allowed the crew to make great progress this last month. You will be able to see it when you attend Open House on May 24th.



Construction workers continue to work on getting the building "dried in" so that they can begin working on the inside. The facia boards, the trim around the roof, were primed and painted Meadow Lane blue. Rain gutters were installed. Moisture barriers were installed around window and door openings to seal and prevent leaks. Wire mesh was installed on all outside walls in preparation for stucco to be applied.










