- You are a citizen of the State of California.
- You are a resident of the Cascade Union Elementary School District.
- You reside within the designated Trustee Area (please see map).
- You are not legally disqualified by the constitution or laws of the State from holding a civil office.
- You are not an employee of the Cascade Union Elementary School District.

Each candidate must submit his/her completed application no later than 4:00 p.m. on April 15, 2026.

For your information, regular board meetings are typically held at 6:00 p.m. on the second Wednesday of each month, with occasional special meetings called. Some personal time is required for Board agenda review, study, and growth in your role as Board member.

If you have any questions about what being a member of the school board might require of you in terms of additional time and responsibility, please contact me or any board member.

Please return the enclosed form to Cascade Union Elementary School District Office, 1645 West Mill Street, Anderson, by 4:00 p.m. on April 15, 2026.

Once all forms have been submitted, the board will then review them. The Board will interview candidates during Open Session at a Special Board Meeting on a date to be determined.

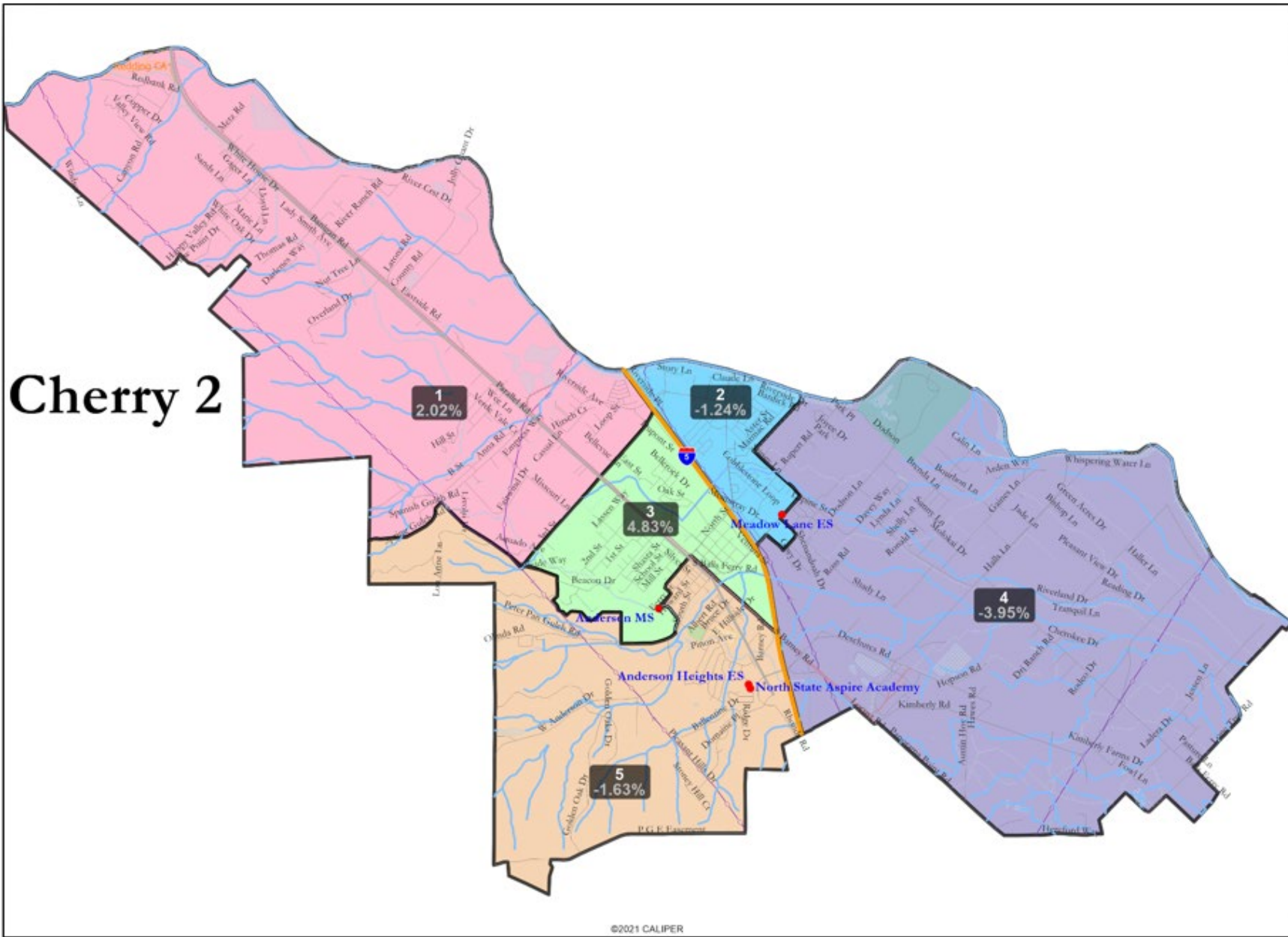
