Overall, the ponds are in excellent condition this month. There is a lot of floating debris on the ponds right now, mostly falling leaves from trees. They should sink after floating for a few days. There is no significant submersed or shoreline weeds to report.

We have frequently treated Lake LV7 this past month for planktonic algae. The bloom has been reduced, but we have struggled to get complete control. I am going to bring a boat out to treat it. Treating the entire surface may help better control.

We have sent the motor unit for the Lake Rianhard fountain back to Kasco for assessment. Unfortunately, there is a 6-8 week lead time for assessments right now, so it may be a while still before I have anything to report. A fishing hook damaged the wire on the fountain. I do not expect that it will be covered under warranty, and will likely need to be replaced.

The currently active parcels for property owned by Celebration CDD are listed below with updates for each. I have also attached a PDF showing those parcels. Parcels 166 and 167 were inspected by the FDOT appraiser in late September, those appraisals are in progress and we are awaiting an update on same. As you can see from the attached email from the FDOT right of way agent, the remaining parcels are under review pending a potential redesign.

As you know from recent email traffic, we are working with FDOT to assess the scope of the subordinate interests impacted on those parcels and any engineering considerations from those takings. Once our engineers have confirmed whether there will be any physical issues, we will be able to proceed with our negotiations for those areas.

MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

(District Stormwater Ponds)

THIS MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is made and entered into as		
of this day of, 2025, by the CELEBRATION COMMUNITY		
DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, a local unit of special-purpose government organized and		
existing under the laws of the State of Florida (the "District") and

WITNESSETH:		
WHEREAS , Owner is the owner of certain real property on which a golf course is located and on which [] ([_]) ponds (known as []) are located, which are part of the District's stormwater system, situated in Osceola County, Florida, as more particularly depicted on Exhibi :		
"A" attached hereto (the "District Ponds"); and		
WHEREAS, pursuant to the Declaration of Easements recorded in Official Records Book [], Page [], and the [] Plat, recorded in Official Records Plat Book [], Page [], all of the		
Public Records of Osceola County, Florida, the District is the holder of non-exclusive, perpetua		
easements on, over and across the District's Ponds, for the purpose of storm water drainage and		
for certain operation and maintenance of the District Ponds and the appurtenant drainage system		
in accordance with the applicable regulatory permits, including but not limited to South Florida		
Water Management Permit numbers [_] and [_], (the "Permits"), as assigned to the District or		
[_]; and		

WHEREAS, Owner has maintained, and desires to continue maintaining for the term of this Agreement, the District Ponds on the golf course; and

WHEREAS, The District and Owner are desirous of setting forth terms, conditions and obligations with respect to the District Ponds on the golf course, pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of these premises, the sum of Ten and No/100 Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the District and Owner do hereby covenant, stipulate and agree as follows:

1. <u>RECITALS.</u> The District and Owner do hereby agree that the recitals set forth hereinabove are true and correct, and are incorporated herein by reference.

2. <u>COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS, REGULATIONS, RULES AND POLICIES.</u>

(a) At all times, Owner shall use commercially reasonable efforts to cause their agents, guests, invitees, contractors, employees and assigns, to operate in accordance with all applicable laws, statutes, regulations, rules, ordinances, policies, permits and orders related to the District Ponds on the golf course. District is responsible for obtaining and maintaining the Permits required

for the District Ponds on the golf course and the District and Owner must abide by all conditions contained therein.

(b) The District is a local unit of special purpose government created in accordance with the Uniform Community Development District Act of 1980, Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*. Owner agrees to comply with all applicable requirements of the "Sunshine Law," the "Public Records Law," the Community Development Districts Law, and all other statutes and regulations to the extent applicable to Owner or contractor(s) or the District Ponds on the golf course.

3. MAINTENANCE OBLIGATIONS OF OWNER

- (a) Owner agrees and acknowledges that the District Ponds are located on the golf course and constitute a stormwater management operating system for the purposes of stormwater drainage for the District's interconnected environmental resource/stormwater discharge system and is required to operate and be maintained in accordance with the Permits, as well as applicable state and federal laws and regulations. The failure to do so may result in significant damages, as well as fines and penalties to the District and other parties.
- (b) The District Ponds on the golf course shall be maintained in accordance with the requirements of the Permits. Owner shall operate and maintain the District Ponds on the golf course in a sound, commercially reasonable manner; and any decorative elements, berms, aquatic planting, pond bank turf and landscaping shall be maintained in compliance with the Permits and the plans and specifications permitting the installation of such components. Owner shall use commercially reasonable efforts to prevent guests, agents and other invitees from entering the water, swimming and disposing of waste in the District Ponds on the golf course and shall install and maintain signage prohibiting such actions. In the event alligators or other nuisance or dangerous animals are present in the District Ponds on the golf course, signage shall be installed to warn invitees

Qualified, licensed and certified pond management professionals shall be retained by Owner, at Owner's sole expense, to regularly maintain the District Ponds on the golf course, including the performance of water quality testing and maintenance, removal of algae and nuisance aquatic plants and maintenance of pond banks. To the extent possible, Owner shall prevent fertilizer and related chemicals from entering the District Ponds on the golf course, and shall ensure that all landscaping in the area is kept, at a minimum, six (6) feet from pond banks, to prevent grass clippings from entering the ponds.

Owner shall notify the District immediately of any operational problems that are noticed concerning any control structures, pond bank deterioration or dangerous conditions in the District Ponds on the golf course

(c) Copies of any inspections, citations and/or notices of non-compliance received from regulatory agencies by Owner or District shall be provided to the other party within 48 hours of receipt. Owner shall implement any and all reasonable measures necessary to bring the District Ponds on the golf course into compliance promptly and within a reasonable time upon receipt of

any such inspection and/or citation and/or notice. Owner agrees to work with the District to ensure any remedial actions are acceptable to the District.

4. INSURANCE.

- (a) Owner shall maintain or cause to be maintained at all times through the term of this Agreement, at least the following minimum types and amounts of insurance coverage:
- (i) Occurrence based comprehensive general liability insurance (including broad form contractual coverage), with a minimum limit of \$2,000,000 single limit per occurrence, protecting it and District from claims by third parties for bodily injury (including death), property damage, which may arise from or in connection with the of District Ponds; and
- (ii) Occurrence based automobile liability insurance including bodily injury and property damage, including all vehicles owned, leased, hired and non-owned vehicles with limits of not less than \$2,000,000.00 combined single limit covering the District; and
- (iii) Workers' compensation insurance as required by applicable law (or employer's liability insurance with respect to any employee not covered by workers' compensation) with minimum limits of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) per occurrence; and
- (iv) Employers' liability insurance, with a minimum coverage level of \$1,000,000; and
- (v) Pollution liability insurance, with a minimum coverage level of \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
- (b) All such insurance required in Paragraph 4(a) shall be with companies and on forms acceptable to District; the insurance required under paragraph 4(a)(i) shall name the District as an additional insured. Certificates of insurance (and copies of the Certificates of Insurance and endorsements shall be provided at the time of execution of this Agreement and/or upon request of the District. In the event of any cancellation or reduction of coverage, Owner shall obtain substitute coverage as required under this Agreement, without any lapse of coverage to District whatsoever. All contractors retained by Owner for construction or maintenance services shall be required by Owner to maintain the same insurance coverage as listed above, with the exception that pollution liability insurance shall have a minimum coverage level of \$3,000,000 per occurrence.
- **5. INDEMNITY.** Owner agrees to indemnify, save harmless and defend the District, its officers, directors, board members, employees, agents and assigns, from and against any and all liabilities, claims, penalties, forfeitures, suits, legal or administrative proceedings, demands, fines, punitive damages, losses, liabilities and interests, and any and all costs and expenses incident thereto (including costs of defense, settlement and reasonable attorneys' fees, which shall include fees incurred in any administrative, judicial or appellate proceeding) which the District, their officers, directors, board members, employees, agents and assigns, may hereafter incur, become responsible for or pay out to the extent arising out of (i) Owner's breach of any term or provision of this Agreement, or (ii) any negligent act or omission, or intentional act or omission of Owner,

their agents, employees, guests, invitees or contractors, related to this Agreement and/or the District Ponds on the golf course. This provision survives the termination of this Agreement.

- **CONTRACTORS.** If the Owner desires to employ contractors in connection with this Agreement or the operation and management of the District Ponds on the golf course, Owner shall cause such contractors to be fully insured as provided in Section 4(b) and bonded, and Owner shall remain fully responsible under the terms of this Agreement; Owner shall be and remain responsible for all work furnished by contractors related to the District Ponds on the golf course.
- 7. ACCESS EASEMENT FOR DISTRICT PERSONNEL. The District's Engineer specified below and other District Staff, accompanied by the District Engineer (or its agents), shall have the right of access to and to enter the area of the District Ponds on the golf course to inspect, at all reasonable times and during normal business hours, in order to monitor and/or ensure compliance with the terms herein. 8. <u>TERM.</u>

- (a) The term of this Agreement begins on the Effective Date, notwithstanding the date of execution by the parties, and shall run for a period of twenty (20) years (the "Term"). Thereafter, the term shall automatically extend for additional twenty (20) year periods, to renew this Agreement for successive twenty (20) year periods, unless one party provides the other written notice of intent to terminate this Agreement at least one hundred eighty (180) days prior to the expiration of the initial term and any renewal thereafter.
- In the case of an event of default by either party, as applicable, which default has not been cured within ten (10) days after receipt of written notice thereof from the non-defaulting party, the non-defaulting party may terminate this Agreement upon five (5) days prior written notice to the defaulting party; provided, however, that if such default is of such a nature that it cannot be cured within such ten (10) day period, then such period shall be extended for such additional period as may be reasonable necessary to remedy the default but in no event shall such remedy extend beyond any remedial period set by a governmental entity with jurisdiction over the District Ponds on the golf course. Upon termination, Owner shall submit a plan of turnover to the District, and upon the District's approval, Owner shall perform any required removal efforts in accordance with the Permits and this Agreement. Owner shall provide copies of all operational and maintenance contracts related to the District Ponds on the golf course. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, if District or any other governmental entity determines that continued operation and maintenance by Owner of the District Ponds on the golf course presents a risk to the safe and necessary use of the District Ponds or the health, safety or welfare of users of the District Ponds or the public, or if continued operation of the District Ponds on the golf course would violate Florida or federal law, District shall be permitted to terminate this Agreement immediately. Upon termination of this Agreement, all rights and obligations of the parties under this Agreement will immediately cease and terminate (except for indemnification obligations of Owner pursuant to Section 5, which will survive such termination).

9. PUBLIC RECORDS AND OWNERSHIP OF BOOKS AND RECORDS.

- (a) The District has advised the Owner that all documents of any kind relating to this Agreement may be public records and, accordingly, Owner agrees to comply with, and to cause any contractor(s) to comply with all applicable provisions of Florida public records law, including but not limited to the provisions of Chapter 119, *Florida Statutes*. The public records custodian of the District is the District Manager, which is currently Inframark Management Services (the "Public Records Custodian"). Owner shall, to the extent applicable by law:
 - (b) Keep and maintain public records required by District to perform services.

- (c) Upon request by District, provide District with the requested public records or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time at a cost that does not exceed the cost provided in Chapter 119, *Florida Statutes*;
- (d) Ensure that public records which are exempt or confidential, and exempt from public records disclosure requirements, are not disclosed except as authorized by law for the duration of the Agreement term and following the Agreement term if the Owner do not transfer the records to the Public Records Custodian of the District; and
- (e) Upon completion of the Agreement, transfer to District, at no cost, all public records in Owner' possession or, alternatively, keep, maintain, and meet all applicable requirements for retaining public records pursuant to Florida laws.

SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY.** Nothing contained in this Agreement shall cause or be construed as a waiver of the District's immunity or limitations on liability granted pursuant to section 768.28, *Florida Statutes*, or other law, and nothing in this Agreement shall inure to the benefit of any third party for the purpose of allowing any claim which could otherwise be barred under the Doctrine of Sovereign Immunity or by operation of law.
- 11. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION. This Agreement shall be interpreted and enforced under the laws of the State of Florida. The parties will follow the terms of the Agreement only to the extent they are enforceable or permitted under Florida law. Any litigation arising under this Agreement shall occur in a court having jurisdiction in Osceola County, Florida. THE PARTIES WAIVE TRIAL BY JURY AND AGREE TO SUBMIT TO PERSONAL JURISDICTION AND VENUE IN OSCEOLA COUNTY, FLORIDA.
- 12. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>. In the event that any provision of this Agreement is judicially construed to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall then be construed in a manner allowing its validity, or if this leads to an impracticable result, shall be stricken, but in either event, all other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 13. <u>COUNTERPARTS</u>. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts with the same effect as if all parties had signed the same document. All fully executed counterparts shall be construed together and shall constitute one and the same Agreement.

FORM OF 1 POND RESTORATION AGREEMENT (Celebration Community Development District)

THIS POND RESTORATION AGREEMENT (the "Agreement"), effective as of the day of, 2026 (the "Effective Date"), between the CELEBRATION
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT (hereinafter referred to as the "District"), a local unit of special purpose government created under Chapter 190, <i>Florida Statutes</i> , whose mailing address is 313 Campus Street, Celebration, Florida, 34747, and [], a [Florida corporation] (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor"), whose mailing address is [].
WITNESSETH:
Subject to and upon the terms and conditions of this Agreement and in consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the District and Contractor agree as follows:
1. <u>DEFINITIONS</u> .
(a) Agreement. The Agreement consists of: (i) this Pond Restoration Agreement; (ii) the Project Manual for Request for Proposals for Pond Restoration Services dated [], 2025 attached hereto as Exhibit "A" (the "RFP"); and (iii) the Contractor's Restoration Fee Summary attached hereto as Exhibit "B" (the "Proposal"). The Agreement represents the entire and integrated Agreement between the parties hereto and supersedes all prior negotiations, representation, or agreements, either written or oral. The Agreement may be amended or modified only as set forth below in Article 14. In the event of any conflict between the terms herein and term(s) in the Proposal or the RFP, the terms herein shall prevail. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the order of precedence shall be: (i) this Pond Restoration Agreement; (ii) the RFP; (iii) the Proposal.
(b) <u>Services.</u> The term "Services" or "Work" as used in this Agreement shall be construed to include all activities and services set forth in the Proposal, and all obligations of Contractor under this Agreement, including any addenda or special conditions. If an addendum or additional work is agreed upon by the parties, the Contractor shall be subject to the terms of this Agreement.
2. <u>SCOPE OF SERVICES</u> . A description of the nature, scope, location and schedule of the Services to be performed by Contractor under this Agreement shall be as described in the Proposal. The area to be included under this Agreement may be amended by the mutual consent of the District and the Contractor.
3. <u>COMMENCEMENT OF SERVICES AND TERM.</u> Contractor shall commence the Work on the Effective Date and shall perform same in accordance with any schedules as set forth in the Agreement. The term of this Agreement shall continue for [

(__)] months from the Effective Date, unless sooner terminated, extended or modified as set forth in this Agreement.

4. DISTRICT MANAGER.

- (a) The District's authorized representative (herein referred to as the "District Manager") shall be the District Manager of the District, which is Inframark Management Services, whose mailing address is 313 Campus Street, Celebration, Florida, 34747, Attention: Angel Montagna; provided, however, that the District may, without liability to the Contractor, unilaterally amend this paragraph from time to time by designating a different person or organization to act as its representative and so advising the Contractor in writing, at which time the person or organization so designated shall be the District's representative for the purpose of this Agreement. The District Manager, as the District's authorized representative shall have the authority to direct and enforce the provisions set forth herein, in accordance with the Scope of Services.
- (b) All actions to be taken by, all approvals, notices, consent, directions and instruction to be given by, all notices and other matters to be delivered to, all determinations and decisions to be made by and, in general, all other action to be taken by, or given to, the District shall be taken, given, and made by, or delivered or given to the District Manager in the name of and on behalf of the District, provided, however, that the District (and not the District Manager or any other agents of the District) shall be solely obligated to the Contractor for all sums required to be paid by the District to the Contractor hereunder.

5. <u>COMPENSATION, PAYMENTS AND INSPECTION RIGHTS PRIOR TO FINAL PAYMENT.</u> [THIS SECTION MAY BE REVISED BASED ON THE RFP LANGUAGE]

(b) Work Authorizations shall mean orders or directives issued by the District in addition to, or changing, the Proposal terms. Services performed under a Work Authorization may be paid either on a lump sum basis, a unit price basis, or a time and material basis in the District's sole discretion. Contractor shall not be entitled to compensation for Services outside the scope of Article 2 unless Contractor has obtained prior written authorization of District to perform the same.

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(c) After all of the Work is completed, the District shall have the right to inspect and/or review the Work to accept or deny the sufficiency of the Work before any payment sare required to be made by the District to the Contractor.

6. REPRESENTATIONS, WARRANTIES AND COVENANTS.

- (a) Contractor hereby represents to District that: (i) it has the experience, qualifications and skill to perform the Services as set forth in this Agreement; (ii) it is duly licensed and permitted to observe and perform the terms, covenants, conditions and other provisions on its part to be observed or performed under this Agreement; (iii) has the necessary equipment, materials and inventory required to perform the Services as set forth in this Agreement; (iv) it has by careful examination satisfied itself as to: (a) the nature, location and character of the area in which the Services are to be performed including, without limitation, the surface conditions of the land and all structures and obstructions thereon, both natural and manmade, the surface water conditions of the area, and to the extent pertinent, all other conditions, and (b) all other matters or things which could in any manner affect the performance of the Services.
- (b) Contractor warrants to the District that all materials furnished under this Agreement shall be new unless otherwise specified, and that all Services shall be of good quality, free from faults and defects and in conformance with the Agreement documents.

7.. EMPLOYEES; INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR STATUS.

- (a) All matters pertaining to the employment, supervision, compensation, insurance, promotion, and discharge of any employees of Contractor or of entities retained by Contractor are the sole responsibility of Contractor. Contractor shall fully comply with all applicable acts and regulations having to do with workman's compensation, social security, unemployment insurance, hours of labor, wages, working conditions and other employer-employee related subjects. Contractor shall obtain, for each individual Contractor employs on the District's premises at any time, a criminal background check performed by an appropriate federal or state agency, or by a professional and licensed private investigator, and shall make, based on the results of such background checks, employment suitability determinations for each employee that are reasonable and customary within the Contractor's industry. Contractor shall maintain copies of said background checks on file so long as the subject individual(s) remains in Contractor's employ, and Contractor shall make all background checks available for District's review upon request. Contractor shall enforce strict discipline, compliance with laws and good order among its employees on the District's premises. Contractor shall comply with all requirements of the E-Verify System as set forth in Article 18.
- (b) Contractor is an independent contractor and not an employee of the District. It is further acknowledged that nothing herein shall be deemed to create or establish a partnership or joint venture between the District and Contractor. Contractor has no authority to enter into any contracts or contracts, whether oral or written, on behalf of the District.

8. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS, REGULATIONS, RULES AND POLICIES.

- (a) At all times, Contractor shall operate in accordance with all applicable laws, statutes, regulations, rules, ordinances, policies, permits and orders. Contractor shall adhere to all applicable traffic laws governing the use of vehicles, equipment and personnel in roadways and public spaces. Contractor is responsible for obtaining all permits or other approvals required for the Services.
- (b) Contractor hereby covenants and agrees to comply with all of the rules, ordinances and regulations of governmental authorities wherein the District's facilities are located, as said rules, etc. may specifically relate to Contractor or its Services provided hereunder, at Contractor's sole cost and expense, and Contractor will take such action as may be necessary to comply with any and all notices, orders or other requirements affecting the Services described herein as may be issued by any governmental agency having jurisdiction over Contractor, unless specifically instructed by the District that it intends to contest such orders or requirements and that Contractor shall not comply with the same. Contractor shall provide immediate notice to the District of any such orders or requirements upon receipt of same.
- (c) The District is a local unit of special purpose government created in accordance with the Uniform Community Development District Act of 1980, Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*. Contractor agrees to comply with all applicable requirements of the "Sunshine Law," the "Public Records Law," the Community Development Districts Law, and all other statutes and regulations applicable to Contractor.

9. WORKPLACE ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC SAFETY.

- (a) Contractor agrees to provide a safe and healthy workplace environment for its employees and agents and a safe and healthy environment for the public at all times. Contractor shall promptly correct any unsafe condition or health hazard in its control and shall immediately report any such condition to the District. In addition to all other requirements of this Agreement, Contractor shall comply with all federal, state and local laws and regulations related to health and safety. Further, Contractor acknowledges that all vehicles and equipment must be properly and safely operated and, where applicable, licensed and/or permitted, to operate on public roadways. Contractor acknowledges that it is responsible for public safety issues including but not limited to: proper work methods, use of protective equipment, safe maintenance, traffic control through work zones, and handling and use of materials, vehicles, and equipment. Contractor shall ensure that no employees, agents or other personnel working at Contractor's direction stands within public roadways while performing any work as defined in the Scope of Services.
- (b) Contractor shall ensure that no employees, agents or other personnel working at Contractor's direction blows or discards debris into the roadways or storm drains within the District.
- (c) The Contractor agrees that it alone bears the responsibility for providing a safe and healthy workplace, and that nothing in this Agreement suggests that the District has undertaken or assumed any part of that responsibility.

- (d) Contractor shall, prior to performing any of the Services, provide employees with training to perform their jobs safely, including instruction in proper work methods, use of protective equipment, and safe maintenance, handling and use of materials, vehicles, and equipment. Contractor will not ask or allow any employee to operate any vehicle or equipment until the employee has received all relevant and advisable training. Contractor shall assure that all employees are licensed and/or have all applicable permits, necessary to perform the Services.
- (e) Contractor will furnish, at its expense, all safety and protective equipment required or advisable for the protection of employees.
- (f) Within two (2) business days of discovery of any unsatisfactory safety procedures or of any violation of applicable law or statute guiding safe performance, Contractor shall notify the District Manager in writing, detailing the nature of the violation, the corrective actions taken to remedy future occurrences of similar violations and other such reasonable information as the District Manager may require to ensure safe operations. In the event the District discovers any unsatisfactory safety procedures or any violation of applicable law or statute guiding safe performance, the District shall notify Contractor of the violation and within two (2) business days, Contractor shall provide the District Manager in writing, with the corrective actions taken to remedy future occurrences of similar violations and other such reasonable information as the District Manager may require to ensure safe operations.

10. PUBLIC RECORDS AND OWNERSHIP OF BOOKS AND RECORDS.

- (a) Contractor understands and agrees that all documents of any kind relating to this Agreement may be public records and, accordingly, Contractor agrees to comply with all applicable provisions of Florida public records law, including but not limited to the provisions of Chapter 119, *Florida Statutes*. Contractor acknowledges and agrees that the public records custodian of the District is the District Manager, which is currently Inframark Management Services (the "Public Records Custodian"). Contractor shall, to the extent applicable by law:

- (a) Contractor shall, throughout the performance of its services pursuant to this Agreement, maintain at a minimum:
- (i) Occurrence based comprehensive general liability insurance (including broad form contractual coverage), with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000 single limit per occurrence, protecting it and District from claims for bodily injury (including death), property damage, contractual liability, products liability and personal injury which may arise from or in connection with the performance of Contractor's services under this Agreement, including but not limited to Contractor's use of the District's property for the storage of equipment, or from or out of any act or omission of Contractor, its officers, directors, agents, and employees;
- (ii) Occurrence based automobile liability insurance including bodily injury and property damage, including all vehicles owned, leased, hired and non-owned vehicles with limits of not less than \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit covering all work performed hereunder:
- (iii) Workers' compensation insurance as required by applicable law (or employer's liability insurance with respect to any employee not covered by workers' compensation) with minimum limits of \$100,000 per occurrence; and
 - (iv) Employers liability, with a minimum coverage level of \$1,000,000.
- (b) All such insurance required in Paragraph 11(a) shall be with companies and on forms acceptable to District and shall provide that the coverage thereunder may not be reduced or canceled unless thirty (30) days prior written notice thereof is furnished to District; the insurance required under paragraph 11(a)(i) shall name the District as an additional insured. Certificates of insurance (and copies of all policies, if required by the District) shall be furnished to the District. In the event of any cancellation or reduction of coverage, Contractor shall obtain substitute coverage as required under this Agreement, without any lapse of coverage to District whatsoever.
- 12. <u>SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY</u>. Nothing contained herein, or in the Agreement, or in the Terms and Conditions, shall cause or be construed as a waiver of the District's immunity or limitations on liability granted pursuant to section 768.28, *Florida Statutes*, or other law, and

nothing in this Agreement shall inure to the benefit of any third party for the purpose of allowing any claim which could otherwise be barred under the Doctrine of Sovereign Immunity or by operation of law.

13. <u>INDEMNIFICATION</u>. Contractor agrees to indemnify, save harmless and defend the District, its officers, directors, board members, employees, agents and assigns, from and against any and all liabilities, claims, penalties, forfeitures, suits, legal or administrative proceedings, demands, fines, punitive damages, losses, liabilities and interests, and any and all costs and expenses incident thereto (including costs of defense, settlement and reasonable attorneys' fees, which shall include fees incurred in any administrative, judicial or appellate proceeding) which the District, their officers, directors, board members, employees, agents and assigns, may hereafter incur, become responsible for or pay out to the extent arising out of (i) Contractor's (or its agents, employees or subcontractors) breach of any term or provision of this Agreement, or (ii) any negligent or intentional act or omission of Contractor, its agents, employees or subcontractors, related to or in the performance of this Agreement.

14. MODIFICATIONS, ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE SERVICES.

- (a) A Work Authorization shall be in writing by the District, which shall consist of additions, deletions or other modifications to the Agreement.
- (b) The District may, from time to time, without affecting the validity of the Agreement, or any term or condition thereof, issue Work Authorizations which may identify additional or revised Scope of Services, or other written instructions and orders, which shall be governed by the provisions of the Agreement. The Contractor shall comply with all such orders and instructions issued by the District. Upon receipt of any Work Authorization, the Contractor shall promptly proceed with the work, and the resultant decrease or increase in the amount to be paid the Contractor, if any, shall be governed by the provisions of Article 5 in this Agreement.
- (c) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Article 14, any and all modifications to this Agreement or to the Scope of Services must be in writing, reviewed by the District's counsel and duly executed by the Chairperson of the District and the Contractor.

15. PROTECTION OF PERSONS AND PROPERTY; MONITORING.

- (a) In addition to all other requirements hereunder, the Contractor shall be responsible for initiating, maintaining and supervising safety precautions and programs in connection with the Services, and shall provide all protection to prevent injury to persons involved in any way in the Services and all other persons, including, without limitation, the employees, agents guests, visitors, invitees and licensees of the District and community residents, tenants, and the general public that may be affected thereby.
- (b) All Services, whether performed by the Contractor, its subcontractors, or anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them, and all applicable equipment, machinery, materials, tools and like items used in the Services, shall be in compliance with, and conform to: (i) all applicable laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and orders of any public, quasi-public or other

governmental authority; and (ii) all codes, rules, regulations and requirements of the District and its insurance carriers relating thereto. In the event of conflicting requirements, the more stringent shall govern.

- (c) The Contractor shall at all times keep the general area in which the Services are to be performed, including but not limited to sidewalks, roadways, trails, rights-of-way, open spaces, and all such areas impacted by the Services, clean and free from accumulation of waste materials or rubbish (including, without limitation, hazardous waste), caused by performance of the Services, and shall continuously throughout performance of the Services, remove and dispose of all such materials. The District may require the Contractor to comply with such standards, means and methods of cleanup, removal or disposal as the District may make known to the Contractor. In the event the Contractor fails to keep the general area in which the Services are to be performed clean and free from such waste or rubbish, or to comply with such standards, means and methods, the District may take such action and offset any and all costs or expenses of whatever nature paid or incurred by the District in undertaking such action against any sums then or thereafter due to the Contractor.
- (d) Contractor shall cooperate with and participate in, at no additional cost or charge, all programs, plans or routines for monitoring and reporting to District, as required in the sole discretion of the District, to ensure satisfactory performance of the Services provided hereunder.

16. SUSPENSION OR TERMINATION.

- (a) Anything in this Agreement to the contrary notwithstanding, District shall, in its sole discretion and without cause, have the right to suspend or terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to Contractor.
- (b) If the Contractor should become insolvent, file any bankruptcy proceedings, make a general assignment for the benefit of creditors, suffer or allow appointment of a receiver, refuse, fail or be unable to make prompt payment to subcontractors, disregard applicable laws, ordinances, governmental orders or regulations or the instructions of the District, or if the Contractor should otherwise be guilty of a violation of, or in default under, any provisions of the Agreement, then the District may, without prejudice to any other right or remedy available to the District and after giving the Contractor and its surety, if any, seven (7) days written notice, terminate the Contract and the employment of Contractor. In addition, without terminating this Contract as a whole, the District may, under any of the circumstances above, terminate any portion of this Contract (by reducing, in such as manner as District deems appropriate, the Scope of Service to be performed by the Contractor) and complete the portion of this Contract so terminated in such manner as the District may deem expedient.
- 17. <u>SUBCONTRACTORS</u>. If the Contractor desires to employ subcontractors in connection with the performance of its Services under this Agreement, upon the District's prior written consent:

- (a) Nothing contained in the Agreement shall create any contractual relationship between the District and any subcontractor. However, it is acknowledged that the District is an intended third-party beneficiary of the obligations of the subcontractors related to the Services.
- (b) Contractor shall coordinate the services of any subcontractors and remain fully responsible under the terms of this Agreement; Contractor shall be and remain responsible for the quality, timeliness and coordinate of all Services furnished by the Contractor or its subcontractors.
- (c) All subcontracts shall be written. Each subcontract shall contain a reference to this Agreement and shall incorporate the terms and condition of this Agreement to the full extent applicable to the portion of the Services covered thereby. Each subcontractor must agree, for the benefit of the District, to be bound by such terms and conditions to the full extent applicable to its portion of the Services.

18. COMPLIANCE WITH E-VERIFY SYSTEM.

- (a) The Contractor shall comply with and perform all applicable provisions and requirements of Section 448.095, *Florida Statutes* and Section 448.09(1), *Florida Statutes*. Accordingly, beginning on the Effective Date, to the extent required by Section 448.095, *Florida Statutes*, the Contractor shall enroll with and use the United States Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system to verify the work authorization status of all newly hired employees. The District may terminate this Agreement immediately for cause if there is a good faith belief that the Contractor has knowingly violated Section 448.091, *Florida Statutes*.
- (b) If the Contractor anticipates entering into agreements with a subcontractor for the work, Contractor will not enter into the subcontractor agreement without first receiving an affidavit from the subcontractor regarding compliance with Section 448.095, *Florida Statutes*, and stating that the subcontractor does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with an unauthorized alien. Contractor shall maintain a copy of such affidavit for the duration of the agreement and provide a copy to the District upon request. In the event that the District has a good faith belief that a subcontractor has knowingly violated Section 448.095, *Florida Statutes*, but the Contractor has otherwise complied with its obligations hereunder, the District shall promptly notify the Contractor. The Contractor agrees to immediately terminate the agreement with the subcontractor upon notice from the District. Further, absent such notification from the District, the Contractor or any subcontractor who has a good faith belief that a person or entity with which it is contracting has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), *Florida Statutes*, shall promptly terminate its agreement with such person or entity.
- (c) By entering into this Agreement, the Contractor represents that no public employer has terminated a contract with the Contractor under Section 448.095(2)(c), *Florida Statutes*, within the year immediately preceding the date of this Agreement.

19. NOTICE.

(a) Notices required or permitted to be given under this Agreement shall be in writing, may be delivered personally or by mail, overnight delivery service, or courier service, and shall be given when received by the addressee. Notices shall be addressed as follows:

- (b) Notwithstanding the foregoing, any notice sent to the last designated address of the party to whom a notice may be or is required to be delivered under this Agreement shall not be deemed ineffective if actual delivery cannot be made due to a change of address of the party to whom the notice is directed or the failure or refusal of such party to accept delivery of the notice. Parties may change notice address by delivering written notice by mail, overnight delivery service, or courier service to the other party and such change shall become effective when received by the addressee.
- 20. <u>ATTORNEYS' FEES</u>. If either party hereto institutes an action or proceeding for a declaration of the rights of the parties the Agreement, for injunctive relief, for an alleged breach or default of, or any other action arising out of, the Agreement, or in the event any party hereto is in default of its obligations pursuant hereto, whether or not suit is filed or prosecuted to final judgment, the non-defaulting or prevailing party shall be entitled to its actual attorneys' fees and to any court costs and expenses incurred, in addition to any other damages or relief awarded.
- 21. <u>GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION</u>. This Agreement shall be interpreted and enforced under the laws of the State of Florida. The parties will comply with the terms of the Agreement only to the extent they are enforceable or permitted under Florida law. Any litigation arising under this Agreement shall occur in a court having jurisdiction in Osceola County, Florida. THE PARTIES WAIVE TRIAL BY JURY AND AGREE TO SUBMIT TO PERSONAL JURISDICTION AND VENUE IN OSCEOLA COUNTY, FLORIDA.

- 22. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>. In the event that any provision of this Agreement is judicially construed to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall then be construed in a manner allowing its validity, or if this leads to an impracticable result, shall be stricken, but in either event, all other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 23. <u>NO WAIVER</u>. No failure by either party to insist upon the strict performance of any covenant, duty, contract or condition of this Agreement or to exercise any right or remedy upon a breach thereof shall constitute a waiver of any such breach or of such or any other covenant, contract, term or condition. Any party hereto, by written notice executed by such party, may, but shall be under no obligation to, waive any of its rights or any conditions to its obligations hereunder, or any duty, obligation, or covenant of any other party hereto. No waiver shall affect or alter this Agreement, but each and every covenant, contract, term and condition of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect with respect to any other then-existing or subsequent breach thereof.
- 24. <u>NO MODIFICATION</u>. No modification, waiver, amendment, discharge or change of this Agreement shall be valid unless the same is in writing and signed by the parties against which such enforcement is or may be sought. This instrument contains the entire contract made between the parties and may not be modified orally or in any manner other than by a contract in writing signed by all parties hereto or their respective successors in interest.
- 25. <u>TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE</u>. The time for delivery and/or completion of the work to be performed under the Agreement shall be of the essence of the Agreement.
- 26. ARM'S LENGTH TRANSACTION. This Agreement has been negotiated fully between the parties as an arm's length transaction. In addition to the representations and warranties contained herein, the Contractor acknowledges that prior to the execution of the Agreement it has thoroughly reviewed and inspected the Agreement documents, and satisfied itself regarding any error, inconsistency, discrepancy, ambiguity, omission, insufficiency of detail or explanation. Contractor further acknowledges that the parties have participated fully in the preparation of this Agreement and received the advice of counsel. In the case of a dispute concerning the interpretation of any provision of this Agreement, all Parties are deemed to have drafted, chosen and selected the language, and doubtful language will not be interpreted or construed against any Party.
- 27. <u>COUNTERPARTS</u>. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts with the same effect as if all parties had signed the same document. All fully executed counterparts shall be construed together and shall constitute one and the same contract.

POST-CLOSING CONVEYANCE AGREEMENT

THIS POST-CLOSING CONVEYANCE AGREEMENT (this "Agreement"), dated as of December, 2025 (the "Effective Date-(hereinafter defined),"), is entered into by and between MATTAMY ORLANDO LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (the "Grantor"), whose address is 4901 Vineland Road, Suite 450, Orlando, Florida 32811, and the CELEBRATION COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, a Florida community development district (the "District"), whose address is c/o Inframark, LLC, 313 Campus Street, Celebration, Florida 34747.

WHEREAS, concurrently herewith, Grantor has conveyed to the District those certain infrastructure improvements (collectively, the "**Improvements**") more particularly described in Exhibit "A" to that certain Bill of Sale Absolute and Agreement between the Grantor and District dated of even date herewith (the "**Bill of Sale**"); and

WHEREAS, as part of the Improvements, Grantor is required to install a decorative street name sign located at the intersection of Estuary Lake Loop and Levee Lane in Osceola County, Florida ("Outstanding Street Sign Improvements"); and

WHEREAS, Grantor has ordered the sign for the Outstanding Street Sign Improvements and due to delays in production time, has not yet received the sign to complete the Outstanding Street Sign Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the District is agreeable to accepting ownership and maintenance of the Improvements, subject to the Grantor's completion of the Outstanding Street Sign Improvements in accordance with the terms and conditions hereof; and

WHEREAS, Grantor has installed photometric streetlights (the "**Streetlights**") in several alleys within the District, as such alleys are further described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, following ongoing operational issues with the Streetlights, multiple discussions between District and Grantor, and visits by the manufacturer of the Streetlights, it appears the Streetlights may not continue to operate due to the limited sunlight available in the alleys; and

WHEREAS, to ensure the proper installation and continued operation of the Streetlights, the Grantor agrees to be responsible for the repair of any Streetlights that fail within one (1) year from the Effective Date. In the event of such a failure, the Grantor shall hardwire the affected Streetlights, converting them from solar powered to electrically powered, to ensure continued functionality, bypassing any non-performing or malfunctioning photometric sensors (collectively, the "Streetlight Repairs"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into this Agreement to set forth certain post-closing completion terms for the completion of the Outstanding Street Sign Improvements and the Streetlight Repairs.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the District's willingness to accept the Bill of Sale, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. **Recitals**. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. <u>Outstanding Street Sign Improvements</u>. Within thirty (30) days of executing this Agreement, Grantor agrees to complete the installation of the Outstanding Improvements in accordance with the Island Village at Celebration Phase 1B plans identified as SDP19-0166 and approved by Osceola County (the "Plans"), specifically, the installation of the decorative street name sign located at the intersection of Estuary Lake Loop and Levee Lane in Osceola County, Florida. Upon the certification of the engineer retained by the District ("District Engineer") that the Outstanding Improvements have been completed in accordance with the Plans and any other applicable permits and regulations, the Outstanding Street Sign Improvements shall be deemed a part of the Improvements conveyed to the District.
- Inspection. Within ten (10) business days of Grantor providing written notice to the District that the Outstanding Street Sign Improvements have been completed ("Inspection Period"), the District Engineer shall inspect and certify to the District that the Outstanding Improvements have been completed in accordance with this Agreement, the Plans and any other applicable permits and regulations. In the event the District Engineer determines that the Outstanding Street Sign Improvements have not been completed within the District Engineer's reasonable discretion, the District Engineer shall provide written notice to the Grantor outlining with specificity the reason the Outstanding Street Sign Improvements are not deemed complete ("Denial Notice"). This process shall be repeated until the District Engineer has certified in writing that the Outstanding Street Sign Improvements have been completed in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, the Plans and any other applicable permits and regulations. In the event the District Engineer fails to provide a Denial Notice within the Inspection Period, the Outstanding Street Sign Improvements shall be deemed completed.
- 4. <u>Streetlight Repairs</u>. For a period of one (1) year from the Effective Date, Grantor agrees to repair and/or maintain the Streetlights so that they perform and operate in accordance with the Plans. Upon notification to Grantor from the District or the District Engineer, Grantor shall <u>performcommence</u> the Streetlight Repairs within three (3) days of the notice, as set forth herein. <u>Following the expiration</u>, and shall diligently <u>pursue completion</u> of the <u>one (1) year warranty period</u>, the <u>Streetlights shall be deemed a part of Streetlight Repairs</u>. The <u>District grants</u> Grantor access to perform the Streetlight Repairs on the Improvements-conveyed to the <u>District</u>.

5. Miscellaneous.

- A. <u>Termination</u>. This Agreement shall terminate upon the District Engineer's certification that the installation of the Outstanding Street Sign Improvements and the Streetlight Repairs have each been completed in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, the Plans and any other applicable permits and regulations.
 - B. <u>Modification.</u> No modification, waiver, amendment, discharge or change of

this Agreement shall be valid unless agreed to in writing by both parties.

C. <u>Notices</u>. All notices required or permitted to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed given: (a) when hand delivered, receipt required; (b) the next business day after deposit with Federal Express, UPS or other nationally recognized overnight courier service, with overnight delivery charge prepaid, receipt required; or (c) when transmitted via email. 

Executive Summary

I propose re-introducing quiet, eco-friendly, 2-person electric boat rentals on Lake Rianhard — restoring one of Celebration's most beloved original features in a modern, zero-emission format.

These small round boats (600W / <1 HP motors, 3–5 mph, no wake) will:

- Revive nostalgia from the town's opening years
- Add a year-round, family-friendly attraction to downtown for our Residents, Guests,
 Visitors and Tourists. We propose boats to be Celebration green or any color suggested
- Increase foot traffic and sales for businesses Downtown
- Generate new revenue for the CDD with Lease
- Create minimum of 4-6 local part-time jobs
- Operate with zero liability to the District through comprehensive insurance, liability and waiver forms, and independent operation

This is a low-risk, high-reward enhancement that perfectly matches Celebration's aesthetic and family-oriented identity.

Section 1 – The Opportunity

Lake Rianhard is the undisputed heart of Celebration. Surrounded by restaurants, shops, rocking chairs, and the interactive fountain, it already hosts concerts, festivals, carriage rides, seasonal ice skating, farmers markets, car shows and many other events that draw thousands. Overview

Lake Rianhard electric boats use 600W motors (≈0.8 HP) — well below Florida's 10 HP threshold that triggers additional licensing and registration rules. Operation is classified as a "livery" under §327.54, F.S. All requirements below will be met or exceeded.

§327.54 Florida Statutes – Livery Requirements

Liveries; safety regulations; penalty

- (1) A livery may not knowingly lease, hire, or rent a vessel to any person:
 - (a) When the number of persons exceeds capacity
 - (b) When the vessel is not seaworthy
 - (c) Without the required USCG-approved PFDs and safety equipment

- (2) A livery shall provide pre-rental or pre-ride instruction that includes, but is not limited to: operational instructions, precautions, local rules, and emergency procedures.
- (3) Liveries must keep a record of name, address, time rented/returned for each rental (available for FWC inspection).

No Boating License or Education Required

§327.395, Florida Statutes – Boater safety ID card required only for persons born on or after Jan 1, 1988 operating 10 HP or greater.

• Our 600W motors = <1 HP \rightarrow NO boater safety card or license required for customers or operator.

Vessel Registration – §328.48 Florida Statutes

All motorized vessels used on Florida waters must be registered with the county tax collector.

- Registration decals and numbers will be displayed as required on each boat.
- Registration renewed annually documentation provided to CDD.

FWC Livery Pre-Approval Permit

Florida Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission requires a "Livery Vessel Inspection Pre-Approval" letter/permit.

- Renewed annually on operator's birthday
- Application and current permit will be on file and provided to District.

Required Safety Equipment (Florida & USCG)

Every boat will carry and display:

- □ USCG-approved wearable or throwable PFD for each person (Type I, II, III, IV)
- □ Children age 6 and younger MUST always wear PFD (§327.50, F.S.)
- □ Sound-producing device (whistle)
- □ Navigation lights if operated after sunset
- □ Visual distress signals not required on inland lakes during daylight

Mandatory Pre-Rental Instruction & Checklist

FWC Form FWCDLE-313B (or equivalent) will be used for every rental.

Customer must watch 2-minute safety video and sign acknowledgment that they:

- Understand operating area and rules
- Know location of all safety equipment
- Understand emergency procedures

Copy of signed form kept for 1 year.

Child Supervision & Age Restrictions

- Children 6 and younger: Must always wear USCG PFD (§327.50)
- No minimum operator age for <10 HP vessels when rented from livery
- All children under 14 will be accompanied by adult in same boat

Osceola County & Lake Rianhard Local Rules

- Osceola County has no specific idle-speed zones on Lake Rianhard (confirmed with county marine unit 2025).
- Boats produce no wake and will operate at idle speed by design.
- No known CDD prohibitions on low-power electric rentals

Accident Reporting & Enforcement

- Any accident-causing injury or >\$2,000 damage reported to FWC within 48 hours (§327.301).
- Operator maintains log and cooperates fully with FWC/Osceola Sheriff Marine Unit.
- Annual compliance review with District annually.



FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS Call to Order and Roll Call

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m.

Roll was called and indicated a quorum was present for the meeting.

SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS Pledge of Allegiance

The *Pledge of Allegiance* was conducted.

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS Approval of the Meeting Agenda

The Board approved the meeting agenda.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Public Comment Period

There being none, the Board moved to the next order of business.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Designation of Officers

Resolution 2026-05 Designation of Officers was discussed. The Board agreed to keep as is.

Mr. McLaughlin made a MOTION to approve Resolution 2026-05, seconded by Mr. Filak, with all in favor, unanimous approval, Resolution 2026-05 was adopted.

SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Third-Party Reports and Presentations

With no CROA representative present, the Board moved on to the next agenda item.

With no representative for the Sheriff's Department present, the Board moved on to the next agenda item, as the meeting with the Sherriff's Department is scheduled for December 9, 2025.

SEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Staff Reports

Mr. Simmons presented his field inspection report.

With no United Landscape representative present, the Board moved to the next agenda item.

Mr. Kurth for Premier Lakes discussed minimal algae. Discussion on obtaining a proposal to get a conduit was brought to the attention to the Board, and Mr. Filak and the Board discussed prices.

With no representative present for Clarke, the Board move to the next agenda item.

Mr. Vincutonis presented his report and discussed the ponds. A discussion regarding Mattamy meeting Phase 2A in December for the inspection turnover process was discussed.

Mrs. Carpenter discussed the re Approval of County Interlocal Agreement for Traffic Signage with the Board. Mr. Filak discussed a need for verbiage change to include info/directional signs regarding the big orange signs. Mr. Touzin stated that unless legally required, the county will install the signs. Mr. Hulme stated he still has issue with traffic control signs regarding who determines if the sign is info/directional. Mrs. Carpenter stated that is listed in the manual for signage per the county. Mr. Filak stated if can ask the county to delineate what sign falls under statue 316, to which Mrs. Carpenter stated it is possible to reach out to the county, but need to be cautious so that the District is not liable.

Mr. Hulme discussed wanting to negotiation with the county, and does not feel the agreement fits that. Mrs. Carpenter asked the Board if they want to delay this discussion for a workshop, to which Mr. Hulme stated he would speak with Ray Stangle to attend a workshop for signage. The Board discussed possible dates for the workshop and reached a decision to hold the workshop on January 20, 2025. Mrs. Carpenter stated that hopefully after this, the Board will have a

better idea to what objecting to.

Mrs. Montagna discussed with the Board that she will compile and send out an agenda draft for the Board to review for the December 9, 2025 meeting with the Sherriff.

EIGHTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Business Items

Mr. Abosco discussed the options with the Board for the Pond bank restoration. The Board was presented with two options: P300LW and PP5. P300LW is a lightweight product versus the thicker product PP5. The Board asked for the longevity and usage for each product. Mr. Abosco stated that the PP5 would hold up better over time due to the thickness and quality. The P300LW is thinner, lightweight and is liable to be broken apart by mowers. Due to the thickness of the PP5, it will hold up better overtime regarding sunlight exposure. The Board asked if there was a median product in between the P300LW and PP5. Mr. Abosco stated that the median product is C350 and is one step above the P300LW. The C350 uses coconut straw to hold the seed in place.

Mr. Filak stated that he googled the longevity differences, and that the PP5 had a longevity of 50 years, versus the P300LW stating the longevity of greater than 36 months. The Board stated that PP5 is clearly the better product to last overtime.

Mr. Abosco stated that the cost of the PP5 is 6 percent higher than the P300LW but would be the better option for longevity. The work is completed in the water to the bank. The estimates include seeding. The Board asked if there was a non-woven option, due to fluctuations in water levels during the dry season and if the geo-fabric would become exposed. Mr. Abosco stated that it would stay in place.

The discussion ensued regarding the process. Mr. Abosco explained that he recommended mobilizing and doing only the red pond areas using the excavator in the pond, as it is more costly to move this piece of equipment and to budget and go from pond to pond.

Mr. Filak asked if the price would change if the Board only chose to do anything higher than yellow, and focus on only the ponds in orange, red, and yellow. The ponds listed in blue and green are considered to be incompliance.

Mr. Abosco stated that the cost would only go up if the Board was going back and forth to the pond versus working on one pond at a time. The discussion ensued regarding the ponds listed in blue areas. Mr. Abosco explained that the blue areas are heavily wooded, and the price would go up to \$50-\$100 a foot extra in these areas due to the wooded addition of the slope and that the Board might want to

hold off on doing these areas for the time being. Ideally, the process would be to focus on one pond at a time, finish and mobilize out of the pond.

The Board discussed wanting staff to determine which ponds and sequence into groups as to better know the cost per pond. Mrs. Montagna discussed that the Board needed to decide out of the \$700,000 that was budgeted, to allocate funds from that amount and then work on a section at a time. Mrs. Montagna discussed with the Board sending a draft contract.

The Board discussed the Greenbriar fence proposal and approved for \$1,600.

Mr. Filak made a MOTION to approve the Greenbriar fence proposal for \$1,600, seconded by Mr. McLaughlin, with all in favor, unanimous approval, the fence proposal was approved.

The Board adopted both Resolutions for Conveyance of Improvements in Phase 1A and 1B.

Mr. Filak made a MOTION to approve Resolution 2026-03, and Resolution 2026-04 seconded by Mr. McLaughlin, with all in favor, unanimous approval Resolution 2026-03 and 2026-04 Conveyance of Improvements in Phase 1A and Phase 1B was adopted.

NINTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consent Agenda

The Board approved the consent agenda consisting of the October meeting minutes, financials, and check register.
