

The new school year for grades K-12 at Panhandle Schools begins Wednesday, Aug.14, 2024. This will be a full day of attendance. First day of attendance for PreK classes will be Monday, Aug. 19, 2024.

During the first week of school, parents/guardians are encouraged to have their students ready **five to ten minutes prior** to the listed pick-up time. **Students are assigned to a bus; make sure they are getting on the correct bus at all times. Any changes need to be arranged through the bus garage or office first.** All times are subject to change, depending on student population and may be adjusted after the first week of school. **Please read carefully, as there have been new changes to the town bus stops for the 24-25 school year.**

Student drop off in Raymond: Drop off students in the drop off lane designated alongside the Lincolnwood Gymnasium Parking lot (look for signs and staff). Do not drop off students in the RGS staff or high school parking lot.

- Raymond Students need to be dropped off *AFTER* 7:30pm, to prevent congestion in the drop off line.
- PreK-1st grade Students who will ride the shuttle bus to FGS need to be dropped off in the designated drop off lane *no earlier than 7:25am and no later than 7:30am*, the shuttle bus will leave as soon as the Harvel transfer students get loaded.

Students drop off in Farmersville: Please do not have students at FGS before 7:30am.

Student pick-up:

- FGS students returning to Raymond for pick up will be dropped off at the (Raymond grade school) before/afterschool doors. Parents are asked to wait at the end of the parking lot, alongside School Street for the shuttle bus to drop off students.
- Raymond Grade School Students will be picked up in the Raymond pick up line located in the RGS parking lot at the Before/After School doors.
- Jr High and HS Students can either meet parents at the grade school pick up line or may be picked up in the high school parking lot. However, DO NOT pass any buses with activated stop arms in the school parking lot. Students should NOT walk between, alongside, or in front of any busses. Be aware of all traffic and make sure your children look both ways before crossing the parking lot.

FGS AM Shuttle from LW:

Rural Raymond and Harvel PreK-1st grade students that wish to ride a bus will use a designated bus stop and will then transfer to the FGS shuttle bus in front of the Lincolnwood Gymnasium entrance. Students can wait for the shuttle in the hallway by the gym doors or on nice days outside with the Bus Aid. **If catching the shuttle bus at Lincolnwood, please arrive no earlier than 7:25am and no later than 7:30am, the shuttle bus will leave as soon as the Harvel bus unloads at 7:30am.** These students will return to Raymond at the end of the school day for connection to their regular transportation home.

FGS 2nd Town bus (Bus #18): - Intown Farmersville K-1st grade.

(NOTE: Bus Stop Changes. Students living within 1.5 miles of Farmersville grade school will not be provided Bus transportation. Parents are asked to make other transportation arrangements.

An exception for those residing north of Main St.

1.) Town Bus Stop @ Faye around 7:43am – Stop will be located in the middle of Faye St.

2.) Town Bus Stop @ Rovey St. around 7:46am 3.) Town Bus Stop @ N. Klienbeck around 7:48am

**** The bus will arrive back to FGS around 7:53am.**

FGS PM Shuttle Schedule

- Students at FGS requiring transportation back to Raymond will board shuttle bus #20 at 2:25 pm.

- K-1st grade students living in Farmersville will board bus #18 for town and Sunset Acre stops at 2:35 pm.

- Students being transported to Waggoner will board bus #18 at 2:55 pm.

NOTE: There is no in town bus pick-up on the North/West side of Rt. 48.

Parents are encouraged to remind students to follow bus safety tips:

- Be ready for your bus at least five minutes before it arrives;
- Stand at least three giant steps away from the curb when the bus approaches;
- Line up away from the street when you're boarding the bus;
- Wait until the bus comes to a complete stop, the door opens, and the driver welcomes you before stepping onto the bus;
- Use the handrails to avoid falls;
- Keep your feet and backpack clear of the aisle;
- Sit quietly so the bus driver can concentrate on driving you safely.
- No food or drinks allowed on the buses and water only in water bottles.
- If you have to cross the street in front of the bus, walk on the sidewalk or along the side of the road to a point at least five giant steps in front of the bus. Make sure the bus driver can see you, and you can see the bus driver, then wait for the driver to signal you to cross.
- **Never** walk behind the bus;
- If you drop something near the bus, always tell the bus driver before reaching down to retrieve it.

Students are assigned to a bus; make sure they are always getting on the correct bus. Any changes need to be arranged through the bus garage or the office first. *TIMES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.** Be at the bus stop 5 minutes prior to listed time.
