ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME HISTORY

Nineteen years ago, the Perry Pirate Booster Club authorized the formation of a Hall of Fame Committee to honor Perry Athletes by developing a process to create an Alumni Athletic Hall of Fame.

In March of 1992, Perry Local Schools' Board of Education authorized the concept of the Perry Pirate Booster Club. The Club selected a committee and developed the guidelines for how the Hall of Fame would be established. The policies and procedures were approved by the Booster Club in the spring of 1992.

A committee and public nomination procedure was put into place during the fall of 1992. In January of 1993, 65 individuals qualified to be placed on a ballot for voting by the committee. The first induction class of 21 former Perry athletes, coaches, or community contributors was selected in May of 1993 after receiving sufficient votes for induction. Since its inception, the Hall of Fame committee has inducted a total of 81 athletes, administrators and coaches.

It is our hope that Perry's Athletic Hall of Fame not only honors the accomplishments of our inductees, but also serves to inspire future Perry High students to aspire to the accomplishments of those Hall of Famers who have built the fine tradition of Perry Athletics.

DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI HALL OF FAME HISTORY

In the spring of 2001, the Perry Board of Education established The Distinguished Alumni Hall of Fame to honor former students of Perry High School whose lives are exemplary for both their career accomplishments and their contributions to the well being of others. They have been selected because they have distinguished themselves in their field of study, career or community service. In addition, these individuals will serve as an inspiration to the students of Perry Local Schools, encouraging them to live their dreams and to pursue personal excellence in all future endeavors.

The members of the charter committee of the Distinguished Alumni Hall of Fame began their work early that year. Their task was to establish the policies and procedures that would guide the future selection of all Distinguished Alumni Hall of Fame inductees. These members were nominated by the Board of Education and represented a cross-section of school and community members.

After determining the nominating criteria and process, the final task of the Charter Committee was to recommend individuals to serve on the Selection Committee. This committee was also comprised of a diverse cross-section of people including representatives from the Perry Board of Education, the Perry Historical Society, school administration, staff, students, and community.

MARTHA "BETTY" SHEPARD-BEHM

"Through your hard work in all you do and your dedication and service to the community, you not only will be happy yourself, but make others happy also."

Martha "Betty" Shepard-Behm was raised on the family farm on Shepard Road in Perry, Ohio. Betty attended practical nursing school after graduating from Perry High School and then worked as a practical nurse.

Married on December 24, 1941 to Wilford N. Behm, she joined her husband in his family's business, The Behm Funeral Home. Together they ran Behm Funeral Home until Wilford's untimely death in 1961. Betty took over the helm and ran the funeral home and ambulance service for over 63 years while raising five children and making sure they all graduated from college.

Betty served 25 years on the Madison Library Board where her tenure was highlighted with the construction of the new library on Middle Ridge. She was also a driving force in the construction of the Wesley Wing at Park United Methodist Church. Betty is a proud supporter of the Madison Fine Arts, Perry Library, and Perry United Methodist Church. She was a founding member of the Madison-Perry Chamber of Commerce, and serves as secretary of the Tri County Funeral Directors.

Dennis Hudson (1984) was a gifted athlete whose greatest athletic talent was his speed. Dennis participated in both football and basketball, but it was track and field where he excelled. Mr. Hudson ran sprints for the Pirates and was the team co-captain for three years.

Dennis earned four varsity letters in track and one in football during his years as a Pirate. His accomplishments during his four year career were many. He was a state qualifier his senior year and three time district qualifier, where he won the 100 and 400 meter dashes. On the conference level he was the league champ in the 100, 200 and 400 and was a member of the championship 1600 meter relay team. Mr. Hudson is part of the school record 4 by 100 and 4 by 400 meter relay teams. These records still stand.



Renee Lynch (1999) is considered by many to be the best student-athlete-softball player to come through the Perry program. She was a quality individual and exceptional leader. Miss Lynch was the starting shortstop for four years, leading the team in batting average. She was honored as an All-Ohio player her junior and senior year as well as All-District. Renee was also All-County and All-League in '97, '98, '99. She was the key to the softball team's success during conference and district championships as well as their run to the Regionals.

While Renee earned numerous awards playing softball for Perry High School, she also excelled on the volleyball court and soccer field. During her three years of competing on the volleyball team she was All-League selection for two years, both years being honored as the league's Most Valuable Player.

Miss Lynch received a full athletic scholarship to Kent State University to play softball. During her days at Kent she started all four years and earned Academic All-Conference. She is still the all-time leader in triples at her college alma mater.

Mike Patrick (2000) may arguably be one of the best all around studentathletes to have ever come out of Perry High School. During his four years at PHS he excelled in the classroom and in the athletic arena. It was an era where everyone wanted to be like Mike.

Mike earned many academic and athletic honors while attending Perry. He was one of those rare athletes that kept a balance of academic goals and his athletic goals. While playing for the Pirate basketball team, Mike was selected as an All-Ohio player in his junior and senior years. Other basketball achievements include Lake County Player of the year, Chagrin Valley Conference and school MVP, Associated Press Northeast Ohio District player of the year, News Herald Player of the Year, Plain Dealer Best of the Best and played in the prestigious Ohio North South game. On the Baseball field Mike was a two time All-Ohio selection, All-Lake County, and first team All-Chagrin Valley Conference.

On the scholastic side Mr. Patrick was Class President both his junior and senior years, National Honor Society President, ranked number one in his class, was the class valedictorian, and received the Hugh O'Brien Leadership Award. Mike attended Wheeling Jesuit University on a full athletic scholarship to play basketball where his storybook career followed him as Mike continued to earn many awards for his accomplishments both in and out of the classroom.

- 3. **Honorary** An alumnus or non-alumnus Perry resident may also be chosen for making a significant impact on the Perry Schools athletic program.
